two Ships came in this morning
and two left here to day

Fri day

the 16 day
year 1832

this day all hands in played in
breaking out Cooping and storing
down Oil the Ship Almira had
her fore sail burnt from the
yard by the flash of a gun

November
the 17 day
year 1832

this day all hands in played in
breaking out and Cooping Oil
this day the Ship Rodman
left here home bound

Sun day
November
the 18 day
year 1832

weather three Ships came in side
this morning all hands went
in shear on liberty
