year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes the middle and latter part fine pleasant weather made all sail

Thursday
January
the 3 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather light breeze the middle and latter part strong gales and squally
Lat 27 19 North Long 15 43 1

Friday
January
the 4 day
year 1833

all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and strong breezes got up a fore topmast studding sail boom and set the studding sail
Lat 28 31 North Long 15 5 11

Saturday
January
the 5 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant breezes the middle and latter part light breezes and calm
Lat 27 33 North Long 15 4 15

Sunday
January
the 6 day
year 1833

all these 24 hours light breezes and calm by all the latter part with the top sails up on the cap
Lat 27 21 North Long 15 3 23

Monday
January
the 7 day
year 1833

all these 24 hours strong gales squally and rainier shortline sail to suit the breeze
Lat 27 43 North Long 15 1 47

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Tuesday
January
the 8 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes the middle and latter part more moderate all hands imployed in setting up the fore rigging
Lat 27 57 North Long 14 2 12

Wednesday
January
the 9 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours fine breezes the middle and latter part strong breezes squally and rainier
Lat 27 51 North Long 14 7

Thursday
January
the 10 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant breezes the middle and latter part strong gales took in all sail except the fore sail and main top sail and suddenly under that sail
Lat 28 13 North Long 14 4 12

Friday
January
the 11 day
year 1833

all these 24 hours strong gales squally and rainier men under a close reef main top sail and fore sail
Lat 28 23 North Long 14 1 23

Saturday
January
the 12 day
year 1833

the first part of these 24 hours strong gales the middle and latter part pleasant weather made all sail
Lat 27 49 North Long 13 8 12

Sunday
January
the 13 day
year 1833

all these 24 hours light breezes and calm tacked and unreefed ship eight or ten times
