Saturday
January
the 26 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breeze. The main top gallonet sail. Lat 26.56 North Long 120.15

Sunday
January
the 27 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather the middle and latter part squally raining light breezes and calm. Lat 26.43 North Long 119.11

Monday
January
the 28 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours light breezes the middle and latter part strong breezes and squally saw Whales and bore two boats but got none. Lat 26.28 North Long 118.11

Tuesday
January
the 29 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather at 1 P.M. saw Whales at 3 P.M. bore the boats and got two. Lat 26.08 North Long 117.51

Wednesday
January
the 30 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather at 6 A.M. commenced cutting and at 10 A.M. got them in. Lat 25.37 North Long 117.10

Thursday
January
the 31 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather at 5 A.M. made the land bearing 11 E saw a large number of humpbacked Whales. Lat 24.19 North Long 115.12

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Friday
February
the 1 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours pleasant weather and fine breeze at 5 A.M. saw two Ships and at 7 saw Whales bore two boats but got none. Lat 23.31 North Long 113.37

Saturday
February
the 2 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and light breezes the middle and latter part calm spoke the Ship *Urania* of Esquimaux. Lat 23.07 North Long 112.09

Sunday
February
the 3 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather saw several species of Whales and rather fish. Lat 22.48 North Long 111

Monday
February
the 4 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather the middle and latter part squally raining and calm. Lat 22.31 North Long 110.19

Tuesday
February
the 5 day
year 1833

All these 24 hours squally raining and strong breezes saw several Whales and five Ships one of them hauling. Lat 22.18 North Long 110.12

Wednesday
February
the 6 day
year 1833

The first part of these 24 hours squally raining and strong breezes the latter part pleasant weather and calm. Lat 22.08 North Long 109.52
