fine pleasant light breezes and
calm this day put 30 barrels
of Oil aboard the after hold

year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and fine breezes saw
the Marais islands run all day
with a fine breeze saw several
hump back Whales
Lat 21°34' North Long 100°47'

year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleas.
ant weather at 6 P.M. wore
ship and steer of shore at 5
P.M. stood in again and went
in shore with two boats for
wood Lat 21°30' North Long 100°35'

year 1833 all these 24 hours fine breezes
and pleasant weather saw
three Ships and several Whales
Lat 20°49' North Long 106°53'

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Wednesday

year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours

breezes took in the topgallant sails
fore and aft the latter part
more moderate and

year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes saw
a snook on the Land and cont.
porpoises and saw numbers of them
Lat 18°32' North Long 105°34'

Friday
February
the 15 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather cont two turtle
and jumbled the fore sail
and bent another
Lat 18°11' North Long 104°16'

Saturday
February
the 16 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
clear and calm the middle
and latter part light breezes
this day saw of the fly jill
boom and let it run in
Lat 17°43' North Long 103°20'

Sunday
February
the 17 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes saw
a shoal of black fish
Lat 17°21' North Long 102°28'

Monday
February
the 18 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather saw many
under bottom finbacks
Lat 16°38' North Long 102°37'
