Monday the first part of these 24 hours
March fine pleasant weather the mid-
dle and latter part squally
the 3 day thunder and lightning rain
year 1833 Lat 4 11 North Long 93 31

Tues day the first part of these 24 hours
March fine pleasant weather and breezes
the 4 day at 10 A M saw Whales leave
year 1833 but got none
Lat 3 37 North Long 92 23

Wednesday the first part of these 24
March hours squally and rainy
the 5 day at 9 A M saw Whales
year 1833 leave the boats but got
none the latter part calm
Lat 2 53 North Long 91 5

Thursday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
March weather the middle and latter
the 6 day part squally heavy swell
year 1833 Lat 2 28 North Long 90 32

Friday the first part of these 24
March hours light breezes and
the 7 day squally saw Whales leave
year 1833 but got none
Lat 2 34 North Long 89 3

Saturday the first part of these 24
March hours light breezes and calm
the 8 day the latter part strong breeze
year 1833 saw a ship hauling Oil
Lat 1 21 North Long 87 38

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Sun day the first part of these 24 hours calm
March and light breezes at 11 A M saw
the 9 day Whales leave the boats and got three
year 1833 and cut one in that night
Lat 1 08 North Long 93 18

Monday all these 24 hours fine breezes
March cut in the afternoon saw Whales
the 10 day in the morning and at 9 A M
year 1833 saw Whales again leave the boats
and got two Whales
Lat 00 47 North Long 93 51

Tues day the first part of these 24 hours
March fine breezes saw Whales leave and
the 11 day got one and Whales and at 7
year 1833 P M began to hail
Lat 31 miles North Long 94 38

Wednesday the first part of these 24 hours light
March breezes the latter part strong
the 12 day breezes saw a small vessel
year 1833 steering to the North
Lat 05 1 North Long 95 18

Thursday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
March breezes at 11 A M got three
the 13 day hailing and most of the decks
year 1833 Lat 1 15 North Long 95 51

Friday the first part of these 24 hours
March strong breezes the latter part
the 14 day more moderate and cut the
year 1833 fore hole and he gone to sea
Lat 1 23 North Long 95 58
