the 21 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and strong breezes saw several schools of porpoises
Lat 1.17 South Long 20.38
- Monday
April
the 22 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather and strong breezes this day knocked the fore hole and put down sixty barrels of Oil
Lat 1.23 South Long 20.18
- Tuesday
April
the 23 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours strong breezes squally and rainey saw several lineas in the fore of us at 5 P.M.
Lat 5.2 Miles South Long 20.31
- Wednesday
April
the 24 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours light breezes and calm the latter part squally saw Whales at Sun down
Lat 4.9 Miles South Long 20.31
- Thursday
April
the 25 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours calm the latter part light breezes and squally saw Whales down and got none
Lat 4.3 Miles South Long 20.40
- Friday
April
the 26 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather at 9 P.M. saw Whales down and got one and cut him in at 4 P.M. saw Whales again down and struck one and knocked the iron
Lat 5.0 Miles South Long 20.47

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- Saturday
April
the 27 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours light breezes and calm saw Whales down and got one and cut him in
Lat 5.1 Miles South Long 20.53
- Sunday
April
the 28 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours light breezes and calm all hands in played in hoisting out our Oil
Lat 5.8 Miles South Long 20.51
- Monday
April
the 29 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather the latter part strong breezes squally and rainey
Lat 5.5 Miles South 20.35
- Tuesday
April
the 30 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours strong breezes squally and rainey saw a sail of the South Point of Althermar and a small boat boarder at 10 P.M. in distress for provisions
Lat 5.2 Miles South 20.31
- Wednesday
May
the 1 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours strong breezes squally and rainey saw a sail to the windward of us
Lat 5.8 Miles South Long 20.
- Thursday
May
the 2 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours strong breezes squally and rainey the latter part more moderate and clear
Lat 3.8 Miles South Long 20.38
