the 18 day saw several schools of black
year 1833 fish
Lat 1.13 North Long 89.12

Sunday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
May weather and strong breezes
the 19 day at 4 P.M. came away
year 1833 the flying jibb boom
Lat 1.08 North Long 87.37

Monday the first part of these 24 hours
May strong breezes the latter part
the 20 day more moderate spoke the
year 1833 Ship Charles of New Bedford
and the Ship Charles of London
Lat 1.38 North Long 86.12

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Tues day all these 24 hours strong breezes
May and cloudy sent out the flying
the 21 day jibb boom and bent the jibb
year 1833 Lat 1.05 North Long 85.28
