May
the 27 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather and
light breezes saw one sail
and made the Land at day light
Lat 12 Miles South Long 80 42

Tuesday
May
the 28 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather and strong
breezes at 3 P M Came to an
anchor at T Cambers and saw
three Ships lying at anchor
Lat at 12 was 52 Miles North

Wednesday
May
the 29 day
year 1833 these 24 hours moderate weather
and sun rain got of one raft
of water and tow boats loads
of wood and took another raft
a schoon

Thursday
May
the 30 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather got of one raft of
water and tow boats loads
of wood and put the
water down by low
the Ship Sarah of Nantucket
let here this morning for sea

Friday
May
the 31 day
year 1833 these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather all hands in played
in getting Wood and Water

Saturday
April
1 day year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather the latter
part sun rainner finished
getting wood and Water

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Sunday
April
the 2 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather the Stabbed work in shoar
in liberty and another boat for
putte

Monday
April
the 3 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes the
Labhorn work in shoar on lib
ity and about for putte

Tuesday
June
the 4 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather and strong
breezes at 6 P M took our
anchor and put to sea and under
the changes and stole them below
Lat 5 7 Miles North Long 82 52

Wednesday
June
the 5 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours strong breezes
and cloudy at 5 P M saw
of June Whales leave and got none
saw one Ship
Lat 1 12 North Long 70 12

Thursday
June
the 6 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours moderate
breezes and cloudy saw seven
at finbacks and blackfish
Lat 5 1 Miles North Long 70

Friday
June
the 7 day
year 1833 the first part 24 hours fine
pleasant weather and light
breezes the latter part
strong breezes saw one
small sail
Lat 4 3 Miles North 82 43
