 year 1833 and by of all night

 July weather and light breezes at 2
 the 3 day P.M. came to an anchor at
 year 1833 Payty and we bent our sails

Thursday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands in play
 the 4 day in sending down the yards and
 year 1833 mast and rigging

Friday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands in play
 the 5 day in fitting rigging got the main
 year 1833 topmast in end and the rigging
 set up and a gang of men
 working the ship on the
 cut side

Saturday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands in play
 the 6 day in repairing the ship in one
 year 1833 way on another

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Sunday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands on shore on
 the 7 day liberty Mr Davis was taken
 year 1833 very ill this morning had the
 Doctor from the shore to him

Monday all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
 July all hands in play in fixing Oars
 the 8 day and tending on the concerns the ship
 year 1833 Caporimbo left this part this day
 Mr Davis and another man sick

Tuesday all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
 July all hands in play in various work
 the 9 day brought the ship Mr Davis
 year 1833 went on shore this day to stop a
 day or two

Wednesday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather this day got three Com-
 the 10 day ing and earned the bobs on shore
 year 1833 and commenced on our rigging again
 the bark ship Vermont left here
 this day on account

Thursday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands in play
 the 11 day in stripping and fitting
 year 1833 rigging Mr Davis is still on shore
 sick and two more with him

Friday all these 24 hours fine pleasant
 July weather all hands in play
 the 12 day in various work brought the
 year 1833 ship Mr Davis is no better
