Fri day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather this day the Stalbone Wash on Schoon on liberty the 26 day Lablone Wash painting Ship year 1833

Satur day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all hands in played in painting and another waves work a bought the Ship year 1833 Mr Davis is turned from head to wear

Sun day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all hands on schoon on liberty the Ship Orion the 28 day of Nantucket came in this day year 1833 left the Captain sick on schoon

Mon day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all hands on schoon the 29 day fitting for sea the Ship Pacific came in this day & mance from New Bedford

Tues day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all hands well except the 30 day Mr Davis and he is wear year 1833 no Quin for the ship see

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Wednes day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all hands in played in mending sails the Ship Stenania the 31 day of New Bedford left here this day year 1833

Thurs day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather took the Stalbone anchor on the beam and set up the jib guise and bolapit sails year 1833 two Ships by of one on the beam

Fri day all these 24 hours fine pleasant weather at 4 P.M. took our anchor and put to sea left in company with the George of New Bedford & went out year 1833

Satur day all these 24 hours moderate breeze and cloudy at 5 P.M. spoke the George and took her beef and Bread that we took in Payte for her at 1 P.M. spoke the Galeonda of New Bedford Lat 5 14 South Long 51 37 W

Sun day the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather the latter part cloudy and foggy spoke the Ship Ontario of Nantucket Lat 5 43 S Long 83 40 year 1833

Mon day all these 24 hours low and light breeze ran asail to the leeward and a large number black fish leave the boat for some fish Lat 6 11 S Long 83 40 year 1833
