Fri day all these 24 hours strong gales
August by to 8 hours under the fore sail
the 30 day and last reef main topsail
year 1833 Lat 30 25 South Long 76 11 W

Satur day the first part of these 24 hours
August strong breezes the middle part
the 31 day more moderate the latter part
year 1833 light breezes and calm
Lat 31 08 South Long 76 31

Sun day all these 24 hours light breezes
September and calm sun light rain squalls
the 1 day saw a large number of porpoises
year 1833 Lat 32 42 South Long 76 51

Mon day all these 24 hours light breezes
September and calm and squally tucks
the 2 day the Anchors in an deck and
year 1833 lashed them
Lat 33 09 South Long 76 43

Tues day all these 24 hours light
September breezes and calm and squalls
the 3 day repaired the main topsail
year 1833 Lat 33 50 South Long 76 18

Wednes day the first part of these 24
September hours fine pleasant weather
the 4 day the latter part squally and
year 1833 rainey, and light breezes
Lat 33 45 South Long 76 08

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Thurs day all these 24 hours light breezes
September and calm light squalls of rain
the 5 day the watch in play in vain
year 1833 work about the ship
Lat 34 37 South Long 76 23 W

Fri day the first part of these 24 hours
September moderate breezes the middle
the 6 day and latter part calm with rain
year 1833 Lat 34 42 South Long 76 32 W

Saturday the first part of these 24 hours
September fine pleasant weather and light
the 7 day breezes the latter part strong
year 1833 breezes set the fore topmast
studding sail
Lat 35 37 South Long 76 32 W

Sun day all these 24 hours strong
September breezes at 6 PM tuck in
the top gallant sails and
the 8 day main sail and Spanker
year 1833 at 1 PM all abore reef the
top sails fore and aft
Lat 36 04 South Long 76 12

Mon day the first of these 24 hours
Sept pleasant weather and light
the 9 day breezes the latter part
year 1833 strong gales
Lat 37 37 South Long 76 24

Tues day all these 24 hours strong
Sept gales by to under bare hauled
the 10 day 14 hours then set the foremast
year 1833 Lat 37 16 South Long 75 58
