October
the 16 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
strong breezes the middle and
the latter part more moderate
Lat 42.29 South Long 46.13

Thurs day
October
the 17 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
light breezes and rain
the latter part strong gales
at 5 P M call all hands
and tack in all sail
Lat 41.51 South Long 45.57

Fri day
October
the 18 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
strong gales the latter part
more moderate at 11 P M set
the main top sail and fore
top mast sta sail
Lat 42.29 South Long 45.19

Satur day
October
the 19 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
strong gales at 2 past 11 tack
in the main top sail
Lat 42.04 South Long 45.11
this day got a Lunar Observation
Long 46.03 W.

the 20 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
breezes set the fore top mast
studding sail
Lat 41.57 South Long 44.19

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Mon day
October
the 21 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
light breezes the latter part
part strong breezes repaired
the main top sail
Lat 39.34 South Long 43.39 W

Tues day

the 22 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes
saw several finbacks
Lat 37.50 South Long 40.45 W

Wednesday

the 23 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
light breezes the middle and latter
part squally and strong breezes

year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine breezes the middle part strong
gales the latter part more
moderate saw several Whales

Fri day

the 25 day
year 1833 all these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather and light breezes
mended the fore topsail and
repaired it

Satur day

the 26 day
year 1833 the first part of these 24 hours
fine pleasant weather the
middle and latter part
strong breezes sent up the
main royal mast
