

Remarks Wednesday July 17th 1844

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. steering S. by E middle and latter moderate winds from the southern board, saw Royal bearing S. by S. So Ends

Sat by Obs Long by Chro

Thursday July 18th Begins with light winds from the southern board steering in for Royal. at 3 AM went on shore middle and latter part laying off and on at Royal. hands employed in getting provisions off. So Ends this day. No Obs.

Friday July 19th Begins with pleasant weather, wind from the West. landed Spanish Honey sick. hands employed in getting off provisions. At 6 AM left Royal steering S by W. So Ends. Sat by Obs 37° 16' N

Long by Chro. 28° 05' West

Saturday July 20th Commences with light breezes from the Western board steering S by W. one sail in sight. at 4 PM saw blackfish lowered boats but could not get fast came on board. middle and latter parts pleasant. hands employed on the rigging. So Ends

Sat by Obs 33° 22' North

Long by Chro 27° 05' West

Sunday July 21st All these 24 hours moderate winds from the Western board steering S by W. with all sail set. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends. Sat by Obs 33° 22' N

Long by Chro. 26° 18' W

Monday July 22nd All these 24 hours light winds from the W. steering S.P.W. at 3 PM saw blackfish lowered boats struck 2 iron drees. middle and latter pleasant. hands employed on the rigging. So Ends

Sat by Obs 31° 00' N. Long by Chro 26° 06' W

Tuesday July 23rd 1844

Commences with light wind from the west and cloudy steering S.P.W. with all sail out. middle part the same. latter part rainy. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends. Sat by Obs 29° 34' N

Long by Chro 26° 08' W

Wednesday July 24th

Begins with light winds from N. N. W. steering S. P. W. at 4 PM saw blackfish lowered boats but could not get fast. middle and latter parts wind from the North. hands employed on the rigging one sail in sight. So Ends. Sat by Obs 28° 35' North

Long by Chro 25° 57' West

Thursday July 25th

The first part of these 24 hours winds from the North steering S. P. W. with all sail set. middle and latter parts fresh S. W. trades steering S by W. hands employed on the rigging. So Ends

Sat by Obs 26° 17' N. Long by Chro 25° 42' W

Friday July 26th

All these 24 hours fresh trades steering S by W. with all sail set middle part took in maintop gallant studding sail latter part set it again. employed on the rigging. So Ends Sat by Obs 23° 11' N

Long by Chro 25° 40' W

Saturday July 27th

Commenced with strong trades steering South with thick cloudy weather. middle part light winds from East. latter part thick cloudy weather steering South. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends this day Sat by Obs 21° 48' North

Long by Chro 25° 20' West
