

Remarks Saturday Aug 17th 1844

Begins with strong trade winds from S.E. by E. heading S.W. by W. middle and latter part the same. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends this day. Lat by Obs 6°08' South
Long by chro 21°16' West

Sunday Aug 18th

The first part of these 24 hours fresh trades from the S.East and pleasant heading S.W. by S. with all sail out middle part the same. latter part squally took in fore and main top gallant sail and flying jib. So Ends Lat by Obs 8°31' South
Long by chro 22°10' West

Monday Aug 19th

Begins with strong trades and squally heading S.S.W. middle part took in main top gallant sail latter part more moderate set fore and main top gallant sail. So Ends
Lat by Obs 10°26' S. Long by chro 23°00' W

Tuesday Aug 20th

Commences with strong breezes and squally heading S.S.W. unbent main top gallant sail and bent a new one. at 2 P.M. took in fore and main top gallant sail middle part more moderate set top gallant sail and flying jib heading South latter part the same. hands employed in ships duty So Ends
Lat by Obs 13°11' South Long by chro 23°57' W

Wednesday Aug 21st

These 24 hours fresh breezes from East steering South with pleasant weather. sent down maintop gallant mast and gave hands employed fitting the rigging to a new mast. So Ends
Lat by Obs 15°36' S Long by chro 22°57' W

Remarks Thursday Aug 22nd 1844

Begins with fresh winds from the East steering South at 4 P.M. sent up maintop gallant mast and set fore top gallant sail and flying jib. middle part light breezes. latter part saw a humpback whale lowered boat but did not get fast. came on board and sent maintop gallant yard and set the sail. So Ends
Lat by Obs 17°53' S. Long by chro 22°28' W.

Friday Aug 23rd

Commences with pleasant breezes from E by S steering S by E. set fore topmast studding sail. middle part set fore and main top gallant studding sail. latter part wind E.N.E. steering south unbent the jib and bent a new one. all hands employed trucking out and coopersing the breads. So Ends Lat by Obs 20°12' South
Long by chro 21°57' West.

Saturday Aug 24th

The first part of these 24 hours light breeze from E.S.E. and pleasant steering South all hands employed coopersing bread and stowing back at 4 P.M. finished the breads. middle part rain latter part wind S.E. employed getting the cutting gear aloft. So Ends
Lat by Obs 22°35' S. Long by chro 21°20' W.

Sunday Aug 25th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. and steering South with all sail set. bent main spencers. middle part the same. latter part light breezes from S.E. nothing in sight. hands employed in ships duty So Ends. Lat by act 24°00' South
Long by act 20.09' West
