

Remarks Monday Sept 23rd 1844

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.E. by E. with all sail set "middle part strong" breezes and about latter part sent up main royal yard and bent a new flying jib. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends. Lat by Obs 39° 36' South
Long by Chron 11° 12' West.

Tuesday Sept 24th

Commences with strong breezes from the North steering E.S.E. with all sail set at 2 PM took in flying jib several finbacks in sight. "middle part" wind shifted to the Westward took in top gallant sail. latter part set them again at 8 PM furled jib and mainsail. wind from the N.W. So Ends. Lat by Obs 39° 36' South
Long by Chron 10° 15' East

Wednesday Sept 25th

Begins with strong gales from N.W. with thick cloudy weather steering E.S.E. at 2 PM took in top gallant sail. at 4 PM took in main top sail and hoisted up the boat. at 6 P.M. double reefed the fore and main topsails. middle part heavy gales and a tremendous heavy sea on both in fore topsail and foresail and close reefed the main. and hove to. at 12 midnight pitched of the jib boom and flying jib boom and fore top gallant mast and parted main top sail sheets. all hands employed clearing the deck latter part more moderate set double reefed topsails. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 47' S
Long by Chron 17° 10' East

Thursday Sept 26th

Begins with strong gales from S.S.W. steering E. by S. under double reefed topsails and courses. middle part light winds. latter part fresh breezes from N.W. So Ends. Lat by Obs 37° 56' S. Long by Chron 18° 52' East

Remarks Friday Sept 27th 1844

The first part of this day having fresh breezes from the N.W. steering E.S.E. with pleasant weather employed making a jib boom middle part light breezes. latter part the same set fore topmast. Studding sail. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 29' North
Long by Chron 20° 42' East

Saturday Sept 28th

Begins with light breezes from the N.W. steering E.S.E. at 2 PM saw black fish lowered boat but could not get fast at 4 PM finished jib boom and sent it out middle light winds. latter part fresh breezes from N.E. heading E.S.E. saw one right whale going quick lowered boat but could not get fast. one sail in sight. Lat by Obs 38° 29' South
Long by Chron 21° 44' East

Sunday Sept 29th

Begins with strong breezes from N.E. heading E.S.E. middle part the same latter part calm all hands employed in sending up fore top gallant mast and bending jib. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 41' South
Long by Chron 34° 25' East

Monday Sept 30th

Commences with fresh breezes from E.N.E. and foggy heading S.E. all hands employed setting up top gallant rigging. middle part fresh winds from the N. latter part pleasant set top mast and top gallant studding sail. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 36' S. Long by Chron 26° 37' East

Tuesday Sept 31st

Begins with fresh breezes from the N.W. and cloudy steering E.S.E. employed fitting flying jib boom one sail in sight. saw several finbacks middle and latter parts the same. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 27' S
Long by Chron 30° 12' East
