

Remarks Wednesday October 2nd 1844

Beginning with strong breezes from the Western board, steering E. S. E. with all sail set, middle part squally, latter part pleasant and out flying jib boom. So ends this day. Lat by Obs 37° 50' South Long by chro 34° 20' East

Thursday Oct 3rd

Commenced with fresh windy and squally steering E. S. E. employed felling royal mast. at 6 P.M. took in top gallant studding sails middle part strong breezes from the N.W. took in top mast studding sails latter part wind from the South. So ends Lat by Obs 37° 23' South Long by chro 37° 57' East

Friday Oct 4th

The first of these 24 hours fresh windy from the South steering E. S. E. middle part calm latter part light breezes from N.W. saw two right whales lowered but could not get fast. So ends Lat by Obs 37° 23' South Long by chro 40° 40' East

Saturday Oct 5th

Beginning with strong breezes from the North steering E. S. E. cloudy weather sent up main royal mast and painted starboard boat. middle and latter part strong breezes took in top gallant sails with thick rainy weather. So ends this day. Lat by Obs 37° 38' South Long by chro 44° 54' East

Sunday Oct 6th

Beginning with fresh breezes from the N.W. and pleasant steering E. S. E. set top gallant sails and topmast and top gallant studding sails middle part light breezes from South. latter part light airy and baffled. employed in ships duty. So ends Lat by Obs 37° 47' South Long by chro 47° 30' East

Remarks Monday October 7th 1844

Beginning with light breezes from the South and pleasant steering E. S. E. set top gallant sails and topmast and top gallant studding sails middle part calm latter part light airy from East, heading N. N. E. employed painting boats. So ends Lat by Obs 36° 57' South Long by chro 48° 18' East

Tuesday Oct 8th

Beginning with strong windy from the South steering E. S. E. at 6 P.M. took in top gallant sails several forelocks in sight middle part fresh gales double reefed topsails and took in jib and spanker latter part strong gales. So ends Lat by Obs 37° 53' South Long by chro 52° 43' East

Wednesday Oct 9th

Beginning with strong gales from the North steering E. S. E. with thick cloudy weather at 6 P.M. took in fore and main topsails and mainsail. strong gales with a heavy sea on. middle part the same latter part set fore topsail double reefed. So ends this day. No Obs

Thursday Oct 10th

Commenced with strong gales from the North steering East, under double reefed fore and main topsail and foresail. middle and latter parts steering E. S. E. employed in ships duty. Lat by Obs 37° 18' South Long by chro 55° 48' East

Friday Oct 11th

Beginning with fresh windy from the West steering E. S. E. with all sail set, unbent the fore topsail to mend and bent it again at sunset took in sail at daylight made sail. So ends Lat by Obs 33° 47' South Long by chro 60° 40' East
