

Remarks Saturday October 12th 1844

Begins with strong gales from the West steering E. & E. nothing in sight, middle part strong breezes at 8 A.M. put 2 right whales lowered boats but could not get fast came on board and took in sail. So Ends this day. Lat by Obs 34° 14' South
Long by chro 62° 24' East

Sunday Oct 13th

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. laying too under double reefed main topsail middle and latter part the same hands employed in ships duty. So Ends this day. No Obs.

Monday Oct 14th

Commences with fresh gales and squally set close reefed topsails heading North. saw plenty of finbacks. middle and latter parts strong gales from S.W. laying too. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 50' South
Long by chro 62° 48' East

Tuesday Oct 15th

Begins with strong gales from the S.W. laying too middle and latter parts the same. employed in ships duty. nothing in sight. So Ends Lat by Obs 34° 21' S. Long by chro 63° 7' E

Wednesday Oct 16th

Begins with strong gales from S.W. heading N.E. under close reefed main topsail and foresail middle part moderate. latter part pleasant. employed in painting bow boat. So Ends Lat by Obs 34° 27' S.
Long by chro 63° 17' East

Thursday Oct 17th

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from the western board steering East. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 52' S. Long by chro 66° 00' East

Remarks Friday October 18th 1844

Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. under double reefed topsails. saw right whales lowered boats but could not get fast middle and latter parts the same hands employed in ships duty. So Ends this day. Lat by Observation 33° 37' South
Long by chro 66° 35' East

Saturday Oct 19th

Begins with fresh gales from the S.W. and squally under double reefed topsails saw two right whales lowered boats but could not get fast. at sunset took in sail. middle part moderate at sunrise made sail heading East. latter part pleasant hands employed in ships duty. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 42' South
Long by chro 67° 48' East

Sunday Oct 20th

Begins with fresh winds from the S.W. and pleasant heading S.E. several finbacks in sight. at 4 P.M. strike ship Chas. Phelps of Stonington with no oil at sunset took in sail. middle part pleasant. at daylight made sail heading S.E. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 49' South
Long by chro 68° 14' East

Monday Oct 21st

Commences with light breezes from S.W. and pleasant. at 2 P.M. saw whales lowered boats but could not get fast. at sunset took in sail. ship Chas. Phelps in sight. middle part pleasant at daylight made sail at 10 A.M. made sail saw whales lowered boats but could not get fast. latter part pleasant. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 49' South
Long by chro 68° 37' East
