

Remarks Friday November 8th 1844

Begins with light winds from the West and pleasant weather saw whales lowered boats could not get fast middle part pleasant. latter part saw black fish lowered boats and took seven. So Ends No Obs

Saturday Nov 9th

Commences with fresh breezes from the West saw whales lowered boats struck killed and took to the ship and cut him in. latter part commence boiling. So Ends No Obs

Sunday Nov 10th

Begins with light airs and bafflin saw whales lowered boats struck killed and took him to the ship and cut him in middle part pleasant latter part saw whales lowered boats struck killed and took him to the ship and cut him in. So Ends Lat by Observation 35° 12' South Long by chro 79° 46' East

Monday Nov 11th

Begins with strong breezes from the North at 5 P.M. saw whales lowered boats struck killed and took him to the ship and let him lay along side all night at 8 A.M. commence cutting with fresh gales and thick rainy weather at 11 finish cutting. So Ends Boiling. No Obs.

Remarks Tuesday November 12th 1844

Begins with strong gales from the West employed boiling middle and latter parts the same one sail in sight. So Ends Lat by Obs 34° 25' South Long by chro 79° 08' East

Wednesday Nov 13th

Begins with strong gales from the West employed boiling middle part more moderate latter part fresh gales employed stowing down. So Ends Lat by Obs 33° 23' S. Long by chro 79° 37' E

Thursday Nov 14th

Begins with strong gales from the Western board and raining employed stowing down at 3 P.M. finish stowing down and wire ship heading S. by W. middle part moderate. latter part made sail at 10 A.M. finish boiling three sail in sight. Lat by Obs 33° 29' S. Long by chro 79° 48' East

Friday Nov 15th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Western board heading S. by W. employed stowing down saw whales lowered boats could not get fast came on board and finished stowing down at sunset took in sail middle part moderate at daylight made sail saw one right whale going quick. 3 sail in sight. Lat by Obs 33° 18' South Long by chro 79° 40' East

Saturday Nov 16th

Begins with fine pleasant weather wind from S.E. nothing in sight middle and latter parts the same. employed in ships duty. So Ends this day. Lat by Obs 33° 06' South Long by chro 68° 28' East
