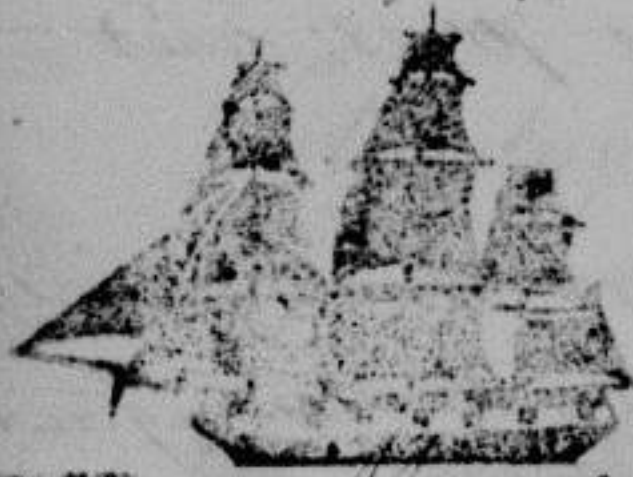


Remarks Sunday November 17th 1844

Begins with fresh breezes from the North and pleasant steering S.W. at 5 p.m. saw one right whale going quick lowered boats could not get fast. at sunset took in sail heading Eastward middle part strong breezes at daylight made sail at 10 A.M. spoke ship *Facitus* of New Bedford with 150 blks of sperm and one right whale. So Ends. Lat. $33^{\circ}30'9''$ Long by chro $70^{\circ}10'6''$



Monday Nov 18th

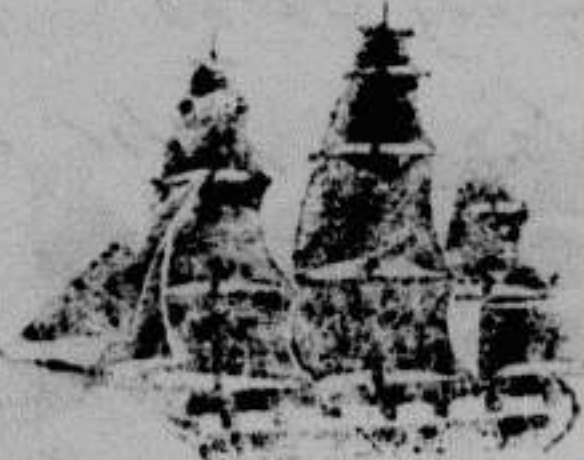
Begins with strong winds from S.E. heading E. S.E. under double reefed topsails. nothing in sight. middle and latter parts strong gales. employed in ships duty. Lat by obs $35^{\circ}24'9''$ Long by chro $71^{\circ}30'8''$

Tuesday Nov 19th

Commences with strong gales from the Western board heading North middle part moderate at daylight made sail latter part strong breezes from N.W. two sail in sight one boiling So Ends Lat $33^{\circ}12'$ S. Long $72^{\circ}21'$ East

Wednesday Nov 20th

Begins with strong breezes from the Northern board heading eastward. at 5 P.M. spoke ship *Leure* of New London with one whale. at sunset took in sail at daylight made sail saw whale lowered boats could not get fast. So Ends with strong gales. Lat by Observation $35^{\circ}22'$ South Long by chro $70^{\circ}10'$ East.



Remarks Thursday November 21st 1844

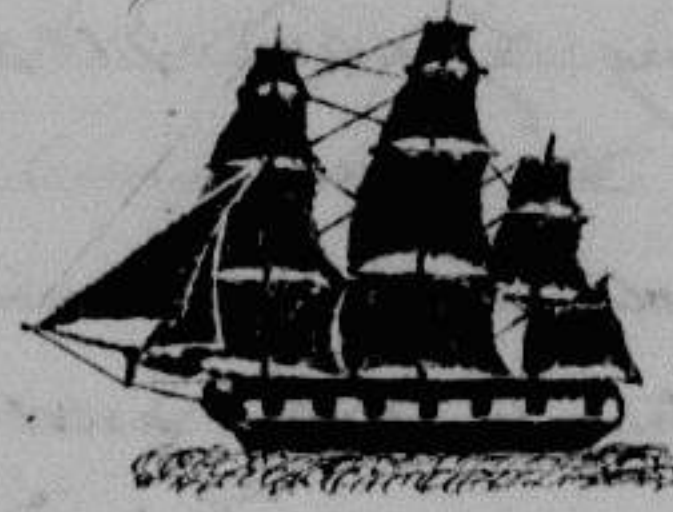
Begins with gales from the Northern board with thick weather gaming with *Leure* saw whale lowered boats but could not get fast at sunset took in sail. at daylight made sail with thick dirty weather. at 8 A.M. strong gales from the North. and rainy. took in sail. Lat by obs $35^{\circ}27'$ South Long by chro $70^{\circ}27'$ East

Friday Nov 22nd

Begins with strong gales from the Northern board and squally. Laying too middle and latter parts the same. hands employed in ships duty. So Ends this day. Lat by obs $35^{\circ}23'$ South Long by chro $72^{\circ}03'$ East

Saturday Nov 23rd

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern board with a heavy sea at 3 P.M. spoke the *Leure* middle part moderate at daylight made sail at 3 A.M. saw one right whale lowered but could not get fast. came on board. So Ends this day Lat by obs $35^{\circ}14'$ South Long by chro $72^{\circ}00'$ East



Sunday Nov 24th

Begins with light airs from S.E. nothing in sight middle and latter part the same So Ends Lat by obs $35^{\circ}08'$ Long by chro $70^{\circ}28'$ East

Monday Nov 25th

Begins with light airs from the Eastern board and pleasant middle and latter parts fresh winds from S.E. saw whale lowered but could not get fast. So Ends Lat $36^{\circ}16'$ S. Long $71^{\circ}48'$ East
