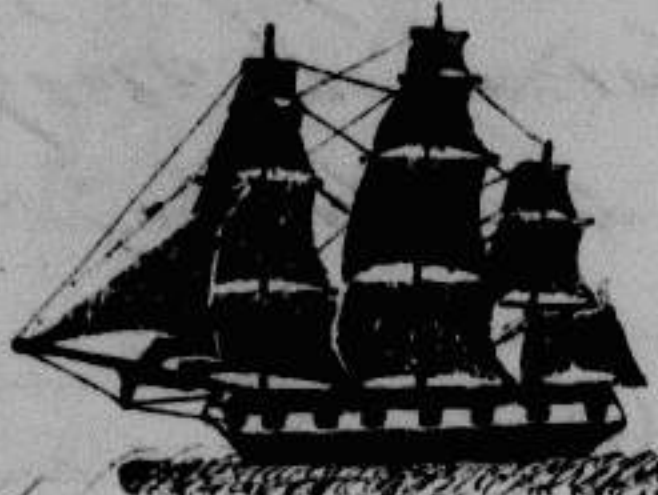


Remarks Tuesday November 26th 1844.

Begins with pleasant weather wind from the S.E. a S.E. 12



saw whales lowered boats struck killed and took him to the ship and cut him in.



saw ship Bingham of Mystic with 6 whales. middle part pleasant latter part saw plenty of whales chased all of the fore noon could not get fast. So Ends.

Sat by obs 36° 36' S. Long by chro 71° 29' E

Wednesday Nov 27th

Begins with light breezes from S.E. saw plenty of whales lowered boats could not get fast. saw the Bingham take a whale, employed boiling. middle part pleasant. latter part the same saw the Bingham take another whale. saw whale lowered but could not get fast. So Ends. Sat 36° 40' S

Long by chro 71° 23' E

Thursday Nov 28th

Begins with light breezes from the North and pleasant saw



whales lowered struck killed and took him to the ship and cut him in middle and latter parts strong gales from the North. So Ends. Sat 36° 20' S. Long 71° 29' E

Friday Nov 29th

Begins with strong gales from the North and rainy at 11 wind shifted to the Southward with heavy gales, employed boiling middle and latter parts moderate. nothing in sight. So Ends.

Sat by obs 36° 27' East Seal

Long by chro 72° 27' East

Remarks Saturday November 30th 1844

Begins with strong gales from S.W. heading N.W. at 4 P.M. finish boiling. middle part squally. at sunrise made sail and commenced stowing down at 11 A.M. finish stowing. So Ends. No log.

Sunday Dec 1st

Begins with light airs from the Southern board. saw black fish lowered lab two. at sunset took in sail middle and latter parts the same. 4 sail in sight. Sat by obs 36° 09' S

Long by chro 71° 18' E

Monday Dec 2nd

Begins with light breezes from the North middle part the same latter part saw whales lowered boats could not get fast. three sail in sight. So Ends. Sat by obs 36° 23' S

Long by chro 71° 18' E

Tuesday Dec 3rd

Commences with light breezes from the North and pleasant. saw whales lowered boats could not get fast. middle and latter parts strong gales from North and rainy. So Ends. No log.

Wednesday Dec 4th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Southern board. saw whales lowered boats could not get fast. middle part the same latter part strong breezes from the North and foggy saw whales could not get fast. So Ends. Sat by obs 37° 03' S

Long by chro 71° 47' E
