

Remarks Saturday December 14th 1844

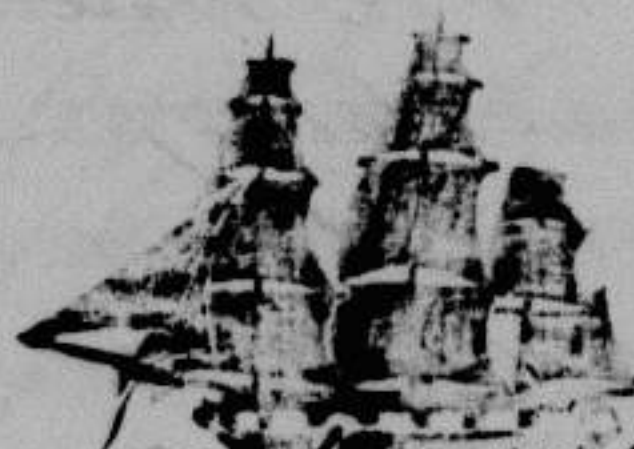
Begins with light air from the Southern board and pleasant heading E. S. E. nothing in sight middle part light breeze from the North latter part fresh breeze from the Western board steering S. S. E. Lat by Obs 39° 12' S Long by Obs 75° 27' W

Sunday Dec 15th

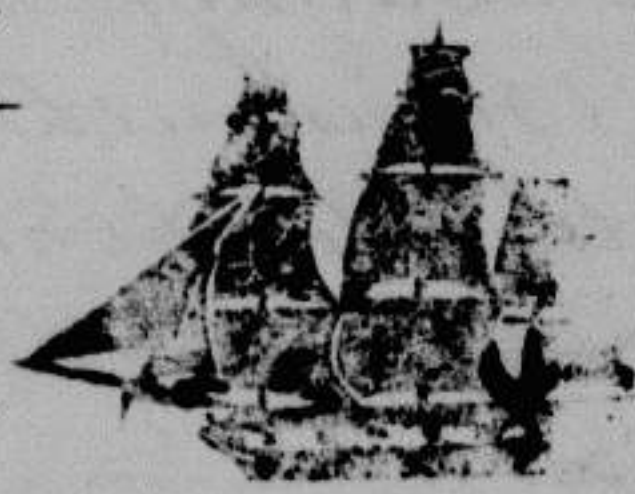
Begins with fresh breeze from the Western board steering S. S. E. middle part moderate at sunrise made sail at 7 A.M. saw whale going quick lowered could not get fast at 8 A.M. saw the island of Amsterdam bearing E. N. E. dist 25 miles running in for the land So Ends. No Obs

Monday Dec 16th

Begins with fresh breeze from the West run in with the land lowered boat went in shore a fishing at sunset came on board middle part laying off and on latter part boats in shore a fishing spoke ship Superior of New London



with three whales and Montezuma of New



London with 700 bbls 75 sperm. So Ends. No Obs

Tuesday Dec 17th

Commences with fresh breeze from the S. W. and equally at sunset boat came aboard and left the island steering S. S. E. middle part the same latter part pleasantly So Ends.

Lat by Obs 38° 24' South

Long by Obs 79° 35' East

Remarks Wednesday December 18th 1844

Begins with fresh breeze from the S. W. and pleasant steering

S. E. by E. spoke ship

Montezuma of New

Bedford with 600

bbls of oil and ship

Herbernia of New Bedford with 7 whales middle part fresh gales latter part fresh gales from the western board laying lee under close reefed main topsail. So Ends. Lat by Obs 39° 05' South

Long by Obs 80° 03' East

Thursday Dec 19th

Begins with heavy gales from the Western board laying lee under close reefed main topsail middle and latter part the same So Ends

Lat by Obs 38° 07' South Long by Obs 82° 15' East

Friday Dec 20th

Begins with strong gales from the Western board kept off and set the fore sail and double reefed topsail steering E. S. E. too sail in sight middle and latter part fresh gales split fore topsail unbent it to repair. So Ends. Lat by Obs 38° 19' South

Long by Obs 84° 38' East

Saturday Dec 21st

Begins with fresh breeze from the S. W. steering S. E. at 4 P.M. finish the fore topsail and bent it at sunset took in sail middle and latter part fresh gales. So Ends. Lat 39° 19' S

Long by Obs 85° 33' E

Sunday Dec 22nd

Begins with fresh gales from the West steering S. E. by E. middle and latter part the same So Ends

Lat by Obs 39° 43' South Long 91° 24' East
