

Remarks Saturday Jan 11th 1843

Begins with light airs from W. S.W. steering S. by E. middle part pleasant. latter part light breezes from the North heading W. S.W. several finbacks in sight. So Ends. Lat by obs 15° 27' S. Long by obs 157° 34' E.

Sunday Jan 12th

Begins with light breezes from the S.E. heading W. S.W. middle part the same. latter part calm. nothing in sight. So Ends. Lat by obs 15° 55' S. Long by obs 158° 15' E.

Monday Jan 13th

Begins with light airs from the Eastward with thick foggy weather heading to the Northward. middle part wind from the S.E. heading S.W. by S. latter part the same. So Ends. Lat by obs 16° 58' S. Long by obs 159° 40' E.

Tuesday Jan 14th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading S. S.W. middle part strong gale took in top gallant sails and double reefed the topsails. latter part heading East. under close reefed main top sail. So Ends. Lat by obs 16° 32' S. Long 160° 13' E.

Wednesday Jan 15th

Begins with strong breezes from W. S.W. set double reefed topsails steering S. S.E. middle part sailing. latter part moderate weather made all sail. nothing in sight. hands employed in ship's duty. So Ends this day.

Lat by obs 38° 34' South
Long by obs 162° 10' East.

Remarks Thursday January 16th 1843

Begins with fresh breezes from W. S.W. and pleasant steering S. S.E. middle part calm. latter part fresh breezes from the S.E. heading S.W. by S. at 10 A.M. took in top gallant sails. So Ends. Lat by obs 37° 52' S. Long 162° 41' East.

Friday Jan 17th

Begins with strong breezes from the Northern board heading W. by S. with equally weather at 5 P.M. hard squalls with thunder and lightning. took in to a close reefed maintop sail and wore ship heading East. at 8 A.M. split maintop sail. middle part tremendous gale from the S.W. latter part more moderate made sail steering S. S.E. unbent maintop sail and bent another. So Ends. Lat by obs 36° 34' S. Long 163° 41' East.

Saturday Jan 18th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.W. steering S. S.E. with equally weather. middle part the same. latter part set fludding sails. So Ends this day. Lat by obs 33° 42' S. Long by obs 163° 20' E.

Sunday Jan 19th

Begins with light breezes from the S.W. steering S. by S. sent up main royal yard and set the sail. middle part light airs from S. W. latter part the same. Lat 32° 34' S. Long by obs 166° 50' E.

Monday Jan 20th

Begins with light breezes from S.W. by S. heading S.E. boat fly jib. middle part light airs from West. latter part fresh breezes. So Ends. Lat by obs 31° 36' S. Long by obs 168° 46' East.
