

Remarks Sunday March 2^d 1845

Begins with light breezes from the eastern board and squally laying off and on, middle and latter parts the
So Ends

Monday March 3^d

All three 24 hours fine weather laying off and entering with the natives for security. found characteristic 18 miles to eastward of Ship. So Ends

Tuesday March 4th

Begins with fresh breezes and squally laying off and on, employed getting off recruits, middle part hard squally, latter part pleasant finish getting off recruits, and run to leeward of the isles. So Ends this day.

Wednesday March 5th

Begins with light breezes from S.E. employed getting off recruits at dark left the land heading S.E. & middle and latter parts squally. So Ends. Lat by Obs 10° 21' S Long by Obs 176° 25' E

Thursday March 6th

Begins with thick squally weather with rain employed stowing away wood, wind from the S.E. heading S.W. by N. middle part thick squally weather, latter part hard rain squally, employed breaking out between decks. So Ends this day. No Observations.

Remarks Friday March 7th 1845

Begins with thick rainy weather with the wind baffling middle part squally, latter part wind baffling with continual rain squalls employed breaking out and cooping the heads. So Ends

Lat by Obs 11° 26' S Long by Obs 176° 26' E

Saturday March 8th

Begins with light airs and baffling with heavy rain squally middle part light breezes from the Northern board, latter part calm employed in ships duty. Lat by Obs 11° 45' S

Long by Obs 176° 37' E

Sunday March 9th

Begins with a calm, middle part the same, latter part light airs and baffling, employed in ships duty. So Ends

Lat by Obs 10° 38' S Long 176° 35' E

Monday March 10th

Begins with light breezes from the Northern board and baffling, middle part calm, latter part light airs from the N.W. heading S.E. by N. So Ends. Lat by Obs 10° 43' S

Long by Obs 177° 05' E

Tuesday March 11th

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the S.W. heading S.E. by N. middle part light airs from N.W. latter part the same. So Ends. Lat 10° 07' S

Long 175° 44' E

Wednesday March 12th Begins with light breezes from N.W. heading S. by E. middle part rainy, latter part hard squally. Split fore and mainmast topmasts
