

Remarks Thursday March 15th 1845
All these 24 hours light breeze from the S.W. with frequent rain squally heading S. & by S. hands employed in ship's duty. So ends with No Obs.

Friday March 16th
Begins with light breeze from S. by W. heading E. S. & E. middle part fresh breeze and squally with in top gallants. Latter part the same. employed in ship's duty. So ends. Lat by obs 6° 10' S. Long by chro 172° 46' E.

Saturday March 17th
Begins with fresh breeze from the S.W. heading S. & E. S. with squally weather a.s.p.m. tacked ship heading W. N. W. middle part rainy. latter part pleasant. employed in ship's duty. So ends. Lat by obs 7° 12' S. Long by chro 172° 33' E.

Sunday March 18th
The first part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from S.W. with frequent showers of rain heading S. & E. middle part squally. latter part wind baffling with frequent showers of rain. So ends this day. No Observation.

Monday March 19th
Begins with fresh breeze from S. S. W. heading S. East. middle part rainy. latter part wind from S. E. heading S. W. by S. employed in ship's duty. So ends. No Observation.

Remarks Tuesday March 18th 1845
Begins with light breeze from the S. E. and pleasant middle part squally. latter part pleasant employed mending sails. So ends this day. Lat by obs 6° 10' S. Long by chro 172° 34' E.

Wednesday March 19th
Begins with light breeze from the S. E. and squally middle part rainy. latter part fresh breeze and squally with frequent showers of rain. sent down fore royal mast. So ends. No Obs.

Thursday March 20th
Begins with thick squally weather wind baffling from S. W. to S. E. struck misson royal mast. middle and latter parts fresh breeze from the S. E. heading S. S. W. employed in ship's duty. So ends. Lat by obs 3° 28' S. Long by chro 173° 58' E.

Friday March 21st
All these 24 hours fresh breeze from the S. E. heading S. S. W. with pleasant weather. hands employed mending sails. Lat by obs 1° 42' S. Long by chro 173° 58' W.

Saturday March 22nd
Begins with fresh breeze from the S. E. heading S. S. W. with all sail set. middle part the same. latter part strong breeze and pleasant employed mending sails. So ends. Lat by obs 0° 45' S. Long by chro. 173° 21' W.

Sunday March 23rd
All these 24 hours strong breeze from S. E. by E. steering S. S. W. middle and latter parts the same. Lat by obs 3° 28' S. Long by chro 173° 58' W.
