

Remarks Monday March 24th 1843

Begins with strong breezes and squally at 5 PM took in topgallant sails. middle part heavy squalls took in jib and mainsail and double reefed the topsails. latter part strong breezes and squally. sent down main, royal yard and mast. So Ends Lat by obs 14° 41' S Long by obs 178° 29' W

Tuesday March 25th

Begins with strong breezes and squally from the S.E. steering N.W. under double reefed topsails. sent in flying jib boom. middle part the same. latter part let the reefs out of the topsails and set topgallant sails. So Ends Lat by obs 6° 16' S Long by obs 179° 44' W

Wednesday March 26th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. and pleasant. steering S.W. employed mending sails. middle part pleasant. latter part the same. employed mending sails. Lat by obs 8° 45' S Long by obs 179° 30' W

Thursday March 27th

Begins with light breezes and pleasant steering S.W. middle part strong breezes. latter part pleasant saw sperm whales lowered boats but could not get fast employed mending sails. So Ends Lat by obs 10° 18' S Long by obs 178° 58' W

Friday March 28th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. steering S.W. middle part the same. latter part strong breezes and cloudy. employed mending sails. So Ends Lat by obs 12° 35' S Long by obs 173° 36' East

Remarks Sunday March 30th 1843

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. steering S.W. with all sail set. middle part the same. latter part squally. employed fitting new cutting pennant. So Ends Lat by obs 15° 08' S Long by obs 171° 39' E

Monday March 31st

Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. and squally steering N.W. middle part the same. latter part the same. So Ends Lat by obs 16° 45' S Long by obs 168° 39' E

Tuesday April 1st

All these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally steering N.W. employed fitting new cutting falls and overhauling cutting blocks and straps. So Ends Lat by obs 17° 40' S Long by obs 168° 53' E

Wednesday April 2nd

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. steering N.W. West middle part the same. latter part pleasant set topmast and topgallant studding sails employed making a fore topsail. So Ends Lat by obs 18° 41' S Long by obs 163° 23' E

Thursday April 3rd

Begins with fresh breezes and rain squally steering W. by S. middle part the same. latter part employed in ships duty. Lat by obs 19° 11' S Long by obs 161° 49' E

Friday April 4th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board steering W. by S. middle part light breezes with rain. latter part pleasant employed in ships duty. Lat by obs 20° 15' S Long by obs 160° 17' East
