

Remarks Saturday April 5th 1845

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board and squally steering N by S with standing sails set. middle part wind from the Western board and pleasant look in shudding sails. latter part pleasant sent up cutting penants
Lat by obs 20° 50' North

Sunday April 6th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Western board heading N by N at 6 A.M. thick squally weather took in top gallant sails at 8 A.M. reefed topsails and took in jib and main sail. wind from the North middle part the same. latter part wind S.E. heading N.W. So Ends Lat by obs 20° 45' North
Long by chro 157° 52' E

Monday April 7th

Commences with strong breezes from S.E. steering S.W. by W middle part the same. latter part more moderate set the jib and mainsail and let the reefs out of the topsails employed in ships duty. So Ends Lat by obs 20° 30' North
Long by chro 155° 45' East

Tuesday April 8th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. steering S.W. at main top gallant sail. middle part the same. latter part pleasant at 7 A.M. saw Bonnets island bearing North distance 5 miles. hands employed in ships duty. Lat 20° 43' North
Long by chro 155° 49' E

Wednesday April 9th Begins with light breezes from E.S.E. steering S.W. middle part light breezes. latter part pleasant employed stowing water between decks. So Ends No observations.

Remarks Thursday April 10th 1845

Begins with light airs and bafflin at 3 P.M. strong breezes from the S.E. with thick dirty weather took in top gallant sails middle part squally latter part pleasant So Ends
Lat by obs 20° 18' North
Long 152° 34' E

Friday April 11th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. heading S.W. by S saw several finbacks. middle part pleasant latter part the same. employed in ships duty. Lat by obs 20° 20' North
Long by chro 151° 11' East

Saturday April 12th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board steering S.W. middle part pleasant. latter part fresh breezes from W.S.W. heading S.W. by S employed in ships duty. Lat 20° 42' North
Long 150° 19' East

Sunday April 13th

Commences with fresh breezes from W.S.W. heading S.W. by S middle part strong breezes from the S.W. at 3 A.M. took in top gallant sails So Ends. Lat by obs 21° 40' N. Long 150° 15' E

Monday April 14th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Western board heading N by W at 1 P.M. set top gallant sails. middle part wind from the Northern heading W.N.W. latter part fresh breezes from S.E. and squally. all hands employed in ships duty. So Ends
Lat by Observations 22° 34' North
Long by Chronometer 150° 10' East
