

Remarks Monday May 19th 1843

Begins with light airs from the Western board heading North started by work, nothing in sight, middle part moderate, latter part strong breezes, saw several whales lowered could not get fast. So Ends. Lat by obs 41° 30' North Long by chro 149° 44' East

Tuesday May 20th

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern board at 5 p.m. saw whales lowered boat struck killed and took him to the ship and took in sail. let the whale lay all night employed bailing at 8 A.M. worked on the whale and began cutting. Lat by obs 40° 39' North Long by chro 149° 33' East

Wednesday May 21st

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. and pleasant employed cutting and bailing at 6 P.M. finish cutting middle part moderate, latter part foggy employed stowing down. So Ends. No Obs.

Thursday May 22nd

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern board with thick rainy weather. at 4 p.m. finish stowing down middle part strong gales and rain. Latter part strong breezes from the Western board employed bailing and stowing down. with nothing in sight. So Ends. Lat by Observation 40° 09' North Long by chronometer 149° 37' East



Remarks Friday May 23rd 1843

Begins with strong breezes from S.W. heading to the S by E employed stowing down and bailing at 4 P.M. finish stowing down middle part moderate, latter part light airs from the Southern board no whales in sight. So Ends. Lat by obs 41° 49' N. Long 149° 20' East

Saturday May 24th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Southern board heading W by S with thick fog at 6 P.M. fog light up, saw whale lowered boat could not get fast middle part thick fog. latter part light airs and baffled with thick fog finished bailing employed stowing down. So Ends. No Obs.

Sunday May 25th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Northern board with thick fog and rain employed stowing down at 5 p.m. finish stowing down middle part strong gales with thick fog. latter part light breezes from the Western board and pleasant at 11 A.M. saw right whale lowered boat struck me killed him and he came on board. So Ends this day employed in ship's duty. Lat by obs 42° 15' North Long by chro 149° 01' East

Monday May 26th

Begins with light breezes from S.W. at 4 P.M. saw whale lowered struck 2 killed me and took him to the ship the other went off spouting blood middle and latter part pleasant. at daylight began cutting at 11 finished. No Obs.
