

Remarks Tuesday May 27th 1845

Begins with strong breeze from the S^W with thick fog and rain cleared up the decks and began boiling middle part strong breeze with fog and rain latter part fresh gale from S^W. Employed boiling. So Ends. Lat by obs 42° 37' S. Long by obs 149° 20' East

Wednesday May 28th

Begins with strong breeze from the S^W heading S^E under close reefed main top sail and foresail employed boiling at dark wore ship to the S^W side board, middle part moderate latter part fresh breeze from S^W. Employed boiling. Lat by obs 42° 37' S. Long 138° 18' East

Thursday May 29th

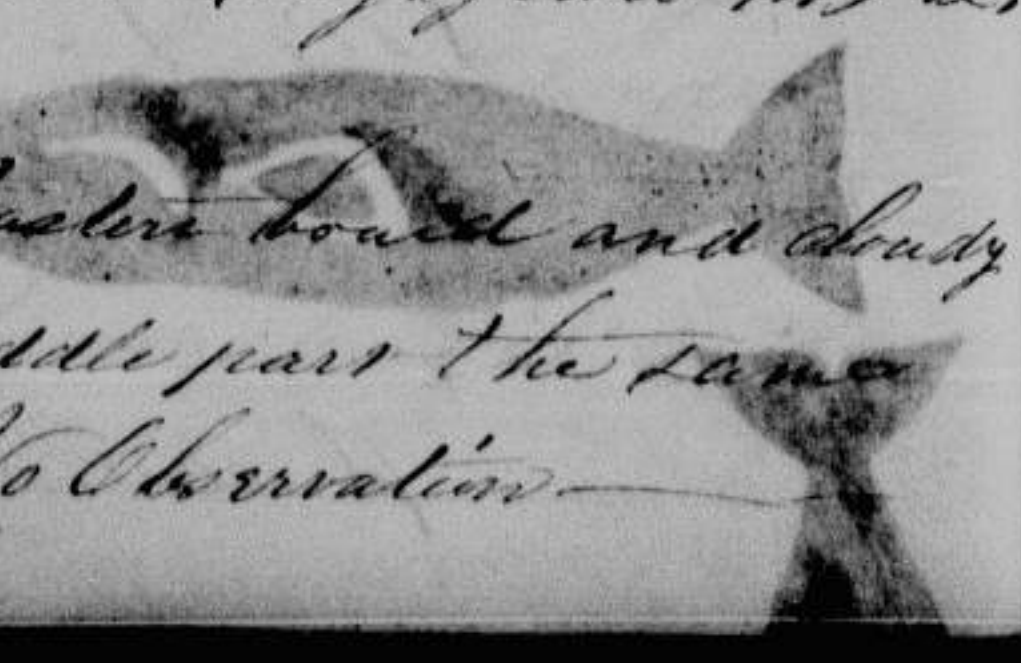
Begins with strong breeze from S^W. heading S^E at 3 P.M. saw whales lowered boats could not get fast middle part fresh boiling latter part thick fog employed stowing down. Lat by obs 42° 32' S. Long by obs 149° 35' East

Friday May 30th

Begins with fresh breeze from S^W. heading S^W employed stowing down, nothing in sight at 5 P.M. finished stowing down and lashed ship heading South middle part light airs from S^W. latter part calm. So Ends. Lat by obs 42° 47' S. Long by obs 149° 12' East

Saturday May 31st


Begins with light breeze from the Eastern board and cloudy steering S^W. nothing in sight middle part the same latter part thick fog. So Ends. No Observations




Remarks Sunday June 1st 1845

Begins with light airs from S^W with thick fog steering S^W at sunset wind shifted to S^W cleared up saw several whales middle part fresh gale. latter part the same. So Ends. Lat 42° 13' S. Long 148° 44' East

Monday June 2nd 1845

Begins with strong breeze from S^W at 8 p.m. saw  (whales lowered boats struck one and the line parted came on board saw more whales could not get fast at dark shortened sail middle and latter part pleasant at 8 A.M. saw one whale lowered boats could not get fast came on board. So Ends. Lat by obs 41° 57' S. Long by obs 148° 39' East

Tuesday June 3rd 1845

Begins with light airs from S^W and pleasant heading East middle part the same at 6 A.M. saw whales lowered boats could not get fast came on board at 10 A.M. saw more whales lowered boats struck one  killed him and took him along side employed getting ready for cutting. So Ends this day. Lat by observation 41° 53' S. Long by obs 149° 13' East

Wednesday June 4th

Begins with fresh breeze from the Southern board. began cutting at sunset finished cutting middle part began boiling latter part fresh breeze from the S^W at 10 A.M. saw whales lowered could not get fast. So Ends. Lat by obs 42° 00' S. Long by obs 149° 20' East
