

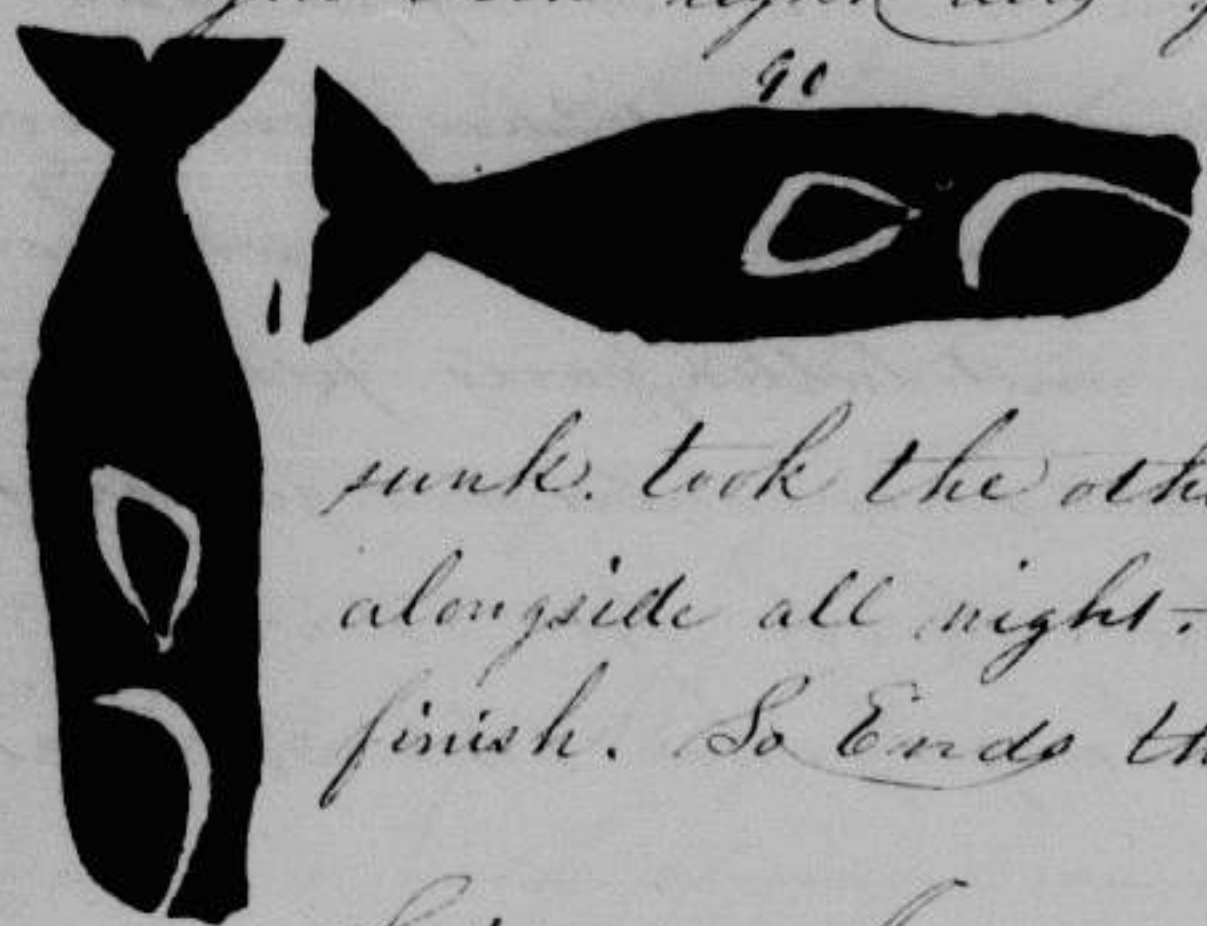
Remarks Thursday June 5th 1845

Begins with fresh gales from the Western board took in fore and misson topsails middle part light breezes from the West. latter part calm employed boiling. So Ends

Lat by obs 42° 37' 38"

Friday June 6th

Begins with light airs from the Western board heading South at 4 P.M. saw 2 whales lowered boats struck two and killed them both and one sunk.



took the other to the ship and let him lay alongside all night. at 8 A.M. began to cut. at 12 finish. So Ends this day. Lat by obs. 42° 35' 30"

Long by chro 148° 46' 00"

Saturday June 7th

Begins with light airs and bafflin employed stowing down and boiling middle part calm latter part light light breezes from the S.W. heading S.E. saw three whales going quick to S.E. employed stowing down. So Ends. Lat by obs 42° 32' 30"

Long by chro 149° 43' 00"

Sunday June 8th

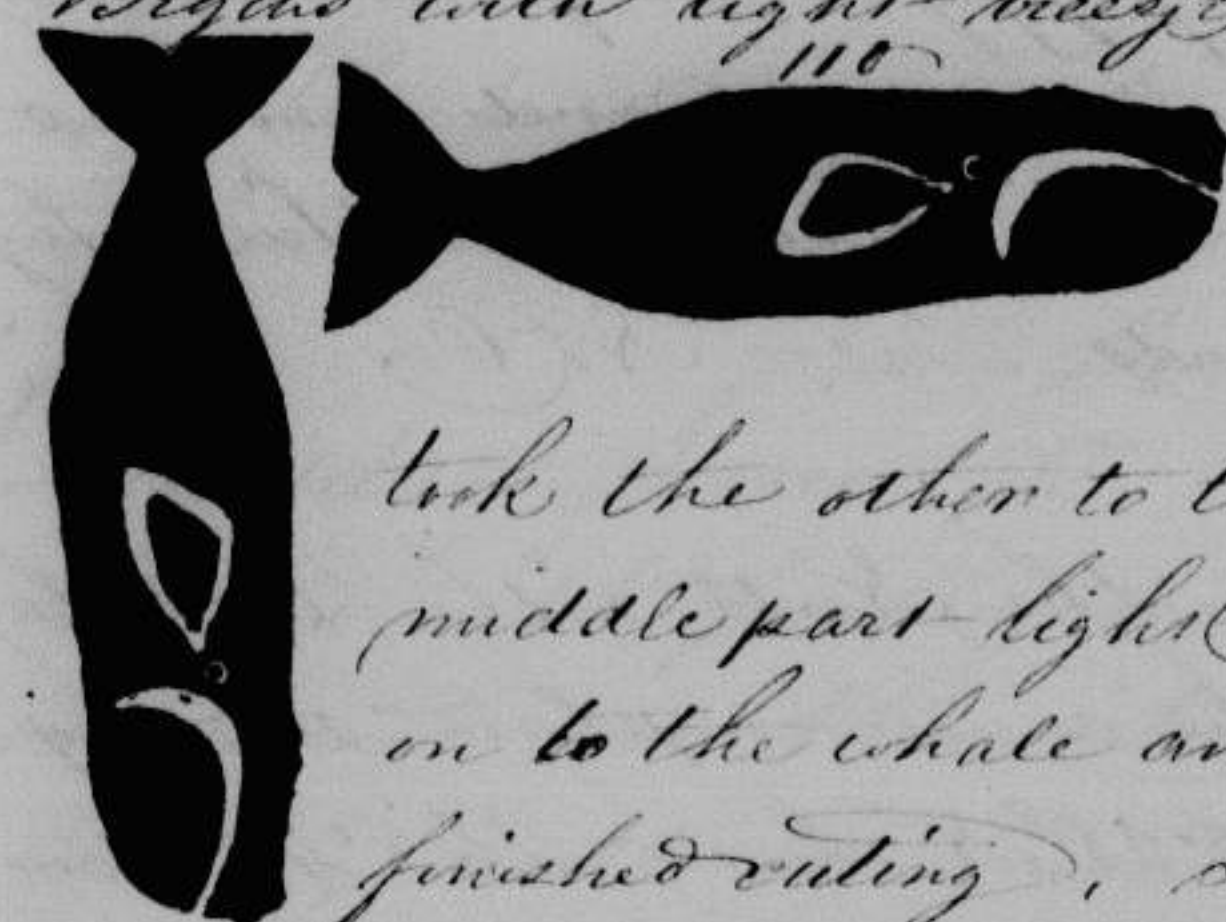
Begins with light breezes from the Southern board and pleasant employed boiling no whales in sight middle and latter parts light breezes from the Eastern board steering South. saw 2 whales going quick. So Ends

Lat by obs 41° 55' 30"

Long by chro 149° 23' East

Remarks Monday June 9th 1845

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board steering South at 3 P.M. saw 2 whales lowered boats struck two and killed them both and one sunk.



took the other to the ship and let him lay alongside all night. middle part light airs and bafflin at 1 P.M. took on to the whale and began cutting at 12, midday finished cutting. So Ends. with No Observation

Tuesday June 10th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board heading South with thick fog employed boiling and stowing down at 6 P.M. finish stowing down. middle part thick fog. latter part light airs from the West and pleasant employed stowing down. So Ends. Lat by obs. 41° 35' 30"

Long by chro 147° 38' 00"

Wednesday June 11th

Begins with light airs from the Western board steering E. N.E. nothing in sight employed boiling middle part pleasant latter part the same employed stowing down. So Ends

Lat by obs 41° 29' 30" Long 148° 40' 00"

Thursday June 12th

Begins with light airs from S.E. heading S.E. with fog. middle part light breezes from East heading South employed boiling latter part wind bafflin with thick fog employed stowing down. So Ends. No Observation
