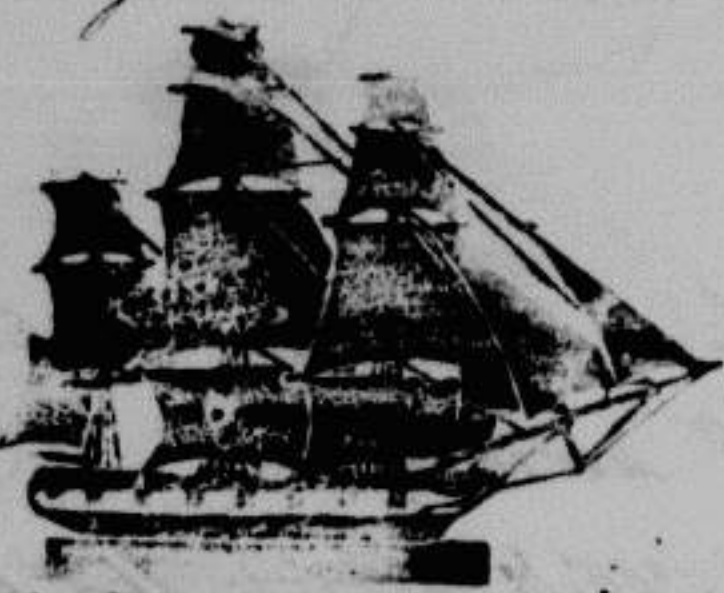


Remarks Wednesday August 13th 1843
 Begins with light breezes from the S.W. steering S.E.
 middle and latter part thick fog set-topmast-studding
 sail steering S.E. by E. hands employed in ships duty.
 S. Ends. No Obs.

Thursday Aug 14th
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. steering S.E. by E.
 bound to the Navigator's islands. middle and latter part
 thick fog. hands employed in ships duty. S. Ends. No Obs.

Friday Aug 15th
 Begins with light breezes from the Western band steering
 S.E. by E. with thick fog. middle part wind S.E. backed ship
 heading S.E. by E. latter part the same. S. Ends.
 Lat by obs. 50° 25' Long 167° 45' East

Saturday Aug 16th
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading S.E. by E.
 at 4 PM spoke ship Sit of Heaven at
 dusk took in topgallant sails and dark-
 nised the topsails. middle and latter
 parts "the same. S. Ends. Lat 50° 32' S.
 Long by obs 171° 38' East



Sunday Aug 17th
 Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. by E. heading E.S.E.
 middle part the same. latter part fresh breezes and pleasant
 saw several whales going quick lowered but could not get
 fast. employed in ships duty. Lat by obs 51° 20' North
 Long by obs 171° 17' East

Remarks Monday August 18th 1843
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. heading E.S.E. mid-
 dle and latter part heading East with cloudy weather.
 nothing in sight. S. Ends. No Observations

Tuesday August 19th
 Begins with light breezes from S.E. heading East with
 thick cloudy weather. middle part the same. latter part fog
 equally low sail in sight. S. Ends. Lat by obs 52° 07' S.
 Long by obs 175° 19' E

Wednesday August 20th
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading S.E. by E. at
 8 PM fresh gale took in topgallant sails middle part strong
 gale with heavy rain equally. latter part strong breezes from the
 S.W. steering S.E. by E. one sail in sight. S. Ends. No Obs.

Thursday August 21st
 Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. steering S.E. by E.
 middle part the same. latter part strong breezes with thick
 weather saw several fin backs. S. Ends. Lat by obs 53° 44' S.
 Long by obs 179° 25' E

Friday August 22nd
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.W. steering S.E. by E.
 middle part the same latter part strong gale. saw two
 right-whales. employed in ships duty. S. Ends. this day
 Lat by act 55° 13' South
 Long by act 178° 23' East
