

Remarks Friday September 12th 1845
Begins with light breezes from E & S steering S by S
middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the Eastern
boards with rain squalls employed in ships duty. To End
Lat 6° 30' N. Long 163° 22' W

Saturday Sept 13th
Begins with light airs from E & S with rain middle
part the same. latter part calm employed in ships duty.
To End Lat 5° 10' N. Long 163° 10' W

Sunday Sept 14th
Begins with light airs and bafflin. middle part light
breezes from the S & S latter part fresh breezes from the
Eastern board heading S by E. To End Lat 3° 47' N.
Long 164° 04' W

Monday Sept 15th
Begins with light breezes from the S & S heading S by W
middle and latter parts heading South. To End this day
Lat 2° 27' N. Long 164° 40' W

Tuesday Sept 16th
Begins with light airs and bafflin. middle and latter
parts the same employed in ships duty. Lat 2° 25' N.
Long 164° 40' W

Wednesday Sept 17th
Begins with light airs and bafflin middle part
the same. latter part calm employed in ships duty.
To End Lat by obs 2° 23' N.
Long by chro 164° 21' W

Remarks Thursday September 18th 1845
Begins with light airs from the Southern board heading E & S East
middle and latter parts the same employed in ships duty.
To End Lat 2° 20' N. Long 164° 05' W

Friday Sept 19th
All these 24 hours light breezes from the S & S heading
S by W. with all sail set employed in ships duty. To End
Lat by obs 1° 23' N. Long 164° 35' W

Saturday Sept 20th
Begins with light airs from the S & S heading S by S
middle and latter parts heading South. employed in ships
duty. Lat by obs 0° 51' N. Long by chro 165° 30' West

Sunday Sept 21st
Begins with light airs from the S & S heading S by East
middle and latter parts the same. hands employed
in ships duty. Lat by obs 0° 46' N. Long 165° 46' West

Monday Sept 22nd
All these 24 hours light breezes from the East steering S by E
middle and latter parts the same. Lat 2° 40' N. Long 166° 00'

Tuesday Sept 23rd Begins with light breezes from East
steering S by S middle part the same
latter part saw 4 sperm whales lowered
boats struck & killed them and took
them to the ship. To End Lat 3° 48' N.
Long by chro 166° 23' West
