

Remarks Wednesday September 24th 1815
Begins with light breezes from S.E. and pleasant em-
ployed cutting middle part steering S by E started by work
latter part pleasant employed boiling. To End Lat 5° 45' S
Long 166° 59' West

Thursday Sept 25th
All these 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant heading
S by E employed boiling. To End Lat 6° 38' South
Long 166° 50' 12

Friday Sept 26th Begins with fresh breezes from
E.S.E. heading S by E middle part finished boiling. lat-
ter part light breezes employed steering down. To End
Lat 7° 37' S. Long 167° 02' W.

Saturday Sept 27th
Begins with light breezes from E.S.E. with frequent rain
squally heading S by E. middle and latter part wind from
the Eastern board steering South. set topmast and top
gallant pludding sails. To End Lat 9° 15' South
Long 167° 12' West

Sunday Sept 28th
Begins with light breezes from the Eastern board
and squally steering South middle part the same
latter part calm. To End Lat 10° 12' South
Long by Log 167° 22' W

Monday Sept 29th
Begins with light airs and baffling middle part the same
latter part light breezes employed repairing sails. To End
Lat by Log 11° 00' S. Long by clock 168° 03' 11

Remarks Tuesday September 30th 1815
All these 24 hours light airs from the S.E. steering S
by N. P.M. employed mending sails. To End this day
Lat 11° 48' Long 168° 47' W

Wednesday Oct 1st
Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. by E steering S by N
middle part the same latter part fresh breezes and cloudy
To End Lat 13° 22' S Long 169° 53' W

Thursday Oct 2nd
Begins with fresh breezes from E.S.E. steering S by N at
1 P.M. saw the island of Tootuilah one of the Society Islands
bearing S by N. dist 21 miles middle part laying off the
island latter part thick squally weather. To End S. by E

Friday Oct 3rd Begins with strong breezes from the South
with heavy rain squally at 1 P.M. saw the island of Pile mid-
dle part the strong gale laying off the island split the
jib and sent down main royal yard and mast, latter part
calm employed in ship's duty. To End S. by E

Saturday Oct 4th Begins with light airs from the S.E.
working up the land middle part calm latter part light
airs from the Eastern board steering down the land. To End

Sunday Oct 5th Begins with light airs from the S.E.
at 1 P.M. took a Pilot boat came to an anchor in Pile harbour
ship Margaret of London laying in the bay. 39 musket
balls sperm oil. To End
