

Remarks Monday October 6th 1845
All these 24 hours pleasant - sent down fore topmast
one watch on shore on liberty. ship Margaret went to
sea. So ends this day

Tuesday Oct 7th Begins with fresh breezy from the SE
and pleasant, middle and latter part the same one watch
on shore employed sending up masts and yards. So ends

Wednesday Oct 8th The first part of these 24 hours
fresh breezy latter part light winds one watch on shore
took on board 3 boat loads of wood. So ends this day

Thursday Oct 9th
These 24 hours pleasant took on board 100 bbls of
water one watch on shore. So ends

Friday Oct 10th All these 24 hours pleasant employed
stowing wood and water watch on shore. So ends

Saturday Oct 11th These 24 hours pleasant employed
in ship's duty. So ends watch on shore

Sunday Oct 12th All these 24 hours pleasant
weather took on board 125 bbls of water one watch
a shore on liberty. So ends this day

Remarks Monday October 13th 1845
All these 24 hours fresh breezy with pleasant weather
one watch ashore on liberty. employed stowing wood and
water and oil taring the ship's body. So ends

Tuesday Oct 14th All these 24 hours light breezy
employed taking aboard wood and water watch on liberty

Wednesday Oct 15th All these 24 hours light breezy
and pleasant employed taking on board wood and water
and stowing it away. So ends this day

Thursday Oct 16th Begins with strong breezy from the
Eastern board employed stowing away wood and water masts
and latter part light breezy employed taking on board
wood and water and stowing it away. So ends

Friday Oct 17th All these 24 hours pleasant employed
getting off wood and stowing it away and getting ready
for sea. So ends this day

Saturday Oct 18th Begins with strong the Eastern
board employed getting ready for sea middle part the same
latter part strong breezy from the Eastern board got
underweigh and put to sea. bound off New Zealand
a whaling. So ends this day
