 in ship's duty. So Ends. Lat by obs. 23°45' South
 Long by obs 170°49' West

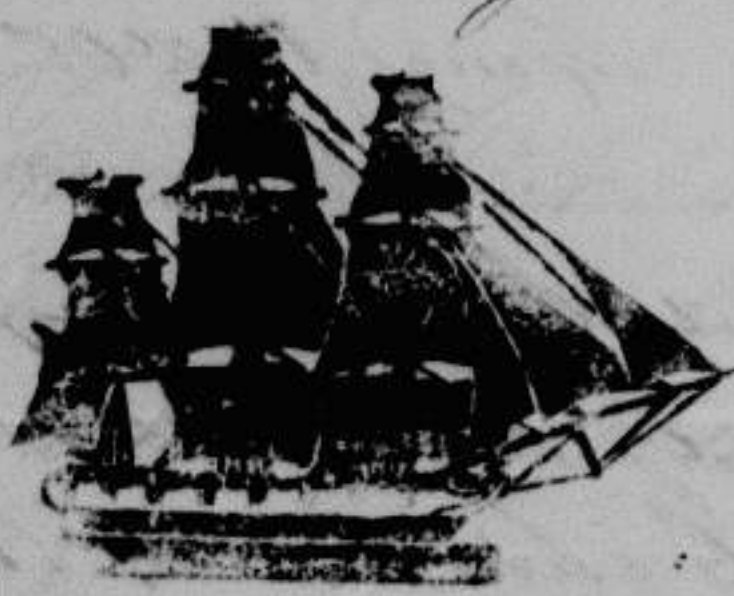
Saturday Nov 1st
 Begins with light airs and bafflin middle and
 latter part calm employed in ship's duty. So Ends
 Lat by obs 23°37' S. Long 170°48'

Sunday Nov 2^d
 All these 24 hours light-airs and bafflin employed
 in ship's duty. So Ends. Lat 24°10' S. Long 170°44' W

Monday Nov 3^d Begins with light breezes from the
 Northern board heading E.S.E. middle part the same
 latter part light breezes from S.E. by S. heading S.W.
 Lat by obs 24°41' S. Long 170°08' W

Tuesday Nov 4th
 Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading S.W.
 at 4 PM took in fore and mizen topgallantsails. middle
 part the same, latter part strong breezes. Lat 24°46' South
 Long 171°17' West

Wednesday Nov 5th
 Begins with strong breezes from S.E.
 heading S.W. by S middle part the same
 latter part spoke ship's and Return of
 New Bedford with 1400 bbls of oil.
 Lat by obs 24°20' S. Long 171°35' W



Remarks Thursday November 6th 1845-
 Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastern board heading
 S.E. middle and latter part the same employed in
 ship's duty. So Ends. Lat 25°00' S. Long 171°25' W

Friday Nov 7th Begins with light breezes from the
 S.E. steering S.E. middle and latter part the same.
 So Ends. Lat 30°31' S. Long 170°35' W

Saturday Nov 8th
 Begins with light breezes from the North steering S.E.
 with cloudy weather. middle part the same. latter part
 steering S.E. So Ends Lat 32°05' S. Long 169°38' W

Sunday Nov 9th Begins with fresh breezes from the
 Northern board steering S.E. middle part the same
 latter part thick dirty weather. saw several spots of whale
 feed. So Ends. Lat by obs 33°29' S. Long 168°31' W

Monday Nov 10th Begins with fresh breezes from
 the Northern board steering S.E. with rainy weather
 middle part the same. latter part saw several finbacks
 So Ends. Lat 34°39' S. Long 168°26' W

Tuesday Nov 11th
 All these 24 hours fresh breezes from the S.W. steering
 S.E. with cloudy weather. finbacks in sight and no
 right-whales. So Ends Lat by obs 36°09' S
 Long by obs 168°46' W
