All these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally from
the Southern board standing on different tack
So Ends. No Observation

Sunday Jan^y 25th

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern board
heading E S E. middle and latter part the same
So Ends. No Observation

Monday Jan^y 26th

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern
board heading E S E. middle part the same tack
ship to S W by S. latter part the same tack
ship to E by S. land in sight. So Ends Lat 11° 44' N
Long 139° 26' West

Tuesday Jan^y 27th

Begins with fresh winds from the S by E heading
in for the land. middle part beating up to the bay
latter part went on shore with one boat. at 11 AM came on
board and stood along. heading S W by W. So Ends Chesday
Lat by obs. 10° 00' S. Long 139° 09' W

Wednesday Jan^y 28th

Begins with fresh breezes from the Southern board heading
S W at 4 PM saw the island of Heraprah bearing S W.
middle part the same. latter part saw Rickahoon bearing
South dist 20 miles. employed making a job. So Ends
Lat by obs. 9° 16' South.
Long by chron 139° 48' West

Remarks Thursday January 29th 1846
Begins with pleasant weather and calm 3 different
islands. Rickahoon. Heraprah. and Nabalit. S of the
Marquesas or Washington islands. middle part fresh
breezes heading S W. latter part the same. employed
in sailmaking. So Ends. Latitude by obs. 8° 31' S
Long by chron 140° 59' W

Friday Jan^y 30th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S S E. heading
S W by S. one island in sight. middle part the
same. latter part fresh breezes heading S S W. So Ends
Lat at 7° 30' S. Long 141° 53' West

Saturday Jan^y 31st

Begins with fresh breezes from the S S E heading
S W by S. with nothing in sight. middle part head
S by W S W. latter part the same. employed in ship
duty. So Ends. Lat 6° 11' S. Long 142° 36' W

Sunday Jan^y 1st

Begins with fresh breezes from the S S E heading
S S W. with pleasant weather. middle part the
same heading South. latter part the same. So Ends
Lat 4° 42' S. Long 143° 18' W

Monday Feb 2nd

Begins with fresh breezes from the E S E heading
South. middle and latter part the same. heading
employed in ship's duty. Lat by obs
Long by chron
