

Remarks Friday February 15<sup>th</sup> 1840

Commences with fresh trades heading S.W. bent the mainsail. saw two finbacks, middle part, fresh trades heading S.W. by W. latter part, the same employed blacksmithing. So Ends. Latitude  $11^{\circ} 48' S$  Longitude  $156^{\circ} 52' W$

Saturday February 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breezes heading S.W. by W. middle part, the same latter part employed heaving out the mizen hatch and cooping it. So Ends this day Lat  $15^{\circ} 31' S$  Long  $158^{\circ} 24' W$

Sunday Feb 17<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh trades steering S.W. by W. with all sail set, employed heaving out oil and cooping it and stowing back, middle part, strong breezes, latter part, the same, employed cooping oil. So Ends. Lat

Monday Feb 18<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breezes from E.S.E. and pleasant, employed cleaning ship, middle and latter part, the same. So Ends. Lat  $16^{\circ} 15' S$  Long  $158^{\circ} 36' W$

Tuesday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours light breezes from the Eastern board heading S. by E. employed on the rigging. So Ends this day Lat  $17^{\circ} 14' S$  Long  $158^{\circ} 42' W$

Remarks Wednesday February 18

Commences with light airs from the Eastern board heading S. by E. middle part, frequent rain, squally latter part, light airs from the Western board set topmast and top gallant studding sails. So Ends. Lat  $17^{\circ} 48' S$  Long  $157^{\circ} 53' W$

Thursday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>

Begins with strong breezes from the Western board steering E. S. E. with all sail set, middle part, the same, latter part, heading S. & by S. So Ends.

Friday Feb 20<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong breezes from the S. West heading S. E. at 3 PM saw the island of Owhyhee one of the Sandwich Isles bearing S. dist. 45 miles, middle part, running for the land, latter part, beating up the isle. So Ends. Lat  $19^{\circ} 02' S$  Long  $158^{\circ} 40'$

Saturday Feb 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with fresh breezes from the Northern board beating up the land, saw the island of Marau bearing North dist. 60 miles, middle part, the same, latter part, calm employed fitting a new fore topsail yard. So Ends. Lat by Obs.  $19^{\circ} 29' S$

Sunday Feb 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins with light airs and frequent rain, squally, middle part, fresh breezes, latter part, the same, stood in to the mouth of Karakakoa bay, saw one ship at anchor. So Ends. Lat  $19^{\circ} 28' S$  Long  $158^{\circ} 56' W$
