

Remarks Monday February 23<sup>rd</sup> 1846  
Commenced with fresh breezes from the Northern  
board standing on different tacks middle part the  
same latter part stood in to the mouth of  
bay, So Ends Lat 19° 43' 38" Long 153° 50' West

Tuesday Feb 24<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light airs standing on different tacks  
middle part the same latter part heading N & N  
Newer in sight, dist 15 miles, So Ends Lat 19° 50'  
Long 156°

Wednesday Feb 25<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light breezes standing on different tacks  
middle part baffling latter part the same employed  
on the rigging So Ends Lat 20° 15' 38"  
Long by chron 156°

Thursday Feb 26<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a calm. Aukhyhee, Mowee, Pooan  
Saherowa in sight, middle part baffling latter  
part fresh breezes from the Western board running  
for Newer harbour, So Ends No Observation

Friday Feb 27<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light breezes at 1 PM came to  
an anchor at Sabaina harbour at the island of  
Mowee, middle and latter pleasant, one watch  
ashore on liberty, So Ends this day

Remarks Saturday February 28<sup>th</sup> 1846  
All these 24 hours pleasant weather, one watch  
ashore on liberty employed in getting off water, So Ends

Sunday March 1<sup>st</sup> 1846

All these 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant one  
watch ashore on liberty two or three ships came in

Monday March 2<sup>nd</sup> The 24 hours fresh airs  
employed in getting water off and stowing it down  
watch on liberty, So Ends this day

Tuesday March 3<sup>rd</sup> All these 24 hours calm  
employed stowing down water, watch on liberty

Wednesday March 4<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours  
pleasant, watch on liberty several ships came in  
to the harbour, So Ends

Thursday March 5<sup>th</sup> Calm weather watch  
on liberty, several ships went to sea, So Ends

Friday March 6<sup>th</sup> Pleasant weather, watch  
on liberty employed stowing down water

Saturday March 7<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours  
pleasant employed calking the ship watch on  
liberty, So Ends
