

Remarks Wednesday April 1st 1846.

Commenced with light breezes from the Eastern
board steering West middle and latter part
the same employed mending sails & landy

Thursday April 2nd

Begins with light breezes and pleasant morning
sails. middle part fresh breezes and squally
look in foretopmast studding sail and fore and
mizzen top gallant sail. latter part strong breezes
and cloudy. S. landy. Lat. 24° 44' N Long 169° 31' W

Friday April 3rd 1846.

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastern board
steering N. N. W. middle and latter part light
breezes. employed in coiling new whale line. Lat. 25° 11' N Long 168° 35' East

Saturday April 4th

Commenced with light breezes from the E
steering N. N. W. middle light bafflin winds
with frequent rain squalls. latter part fresh
breezes wind from the S. W. heading. S. by E with
all sail set. Lat. 24° 11' North. Long 168° 11' East

Sunday April 5th

Begins with light breezes
from the West heading. S. W. middle and
latter part strong breezes from the North head
N. N. W. under double reefed topsails. Lat. 23° 55' N Long 168° 11' East

Remarks Monday April 6th 1846

Begins with strong breezes from the Northern
board heading to the Westward under single reef
topsails middle and latter part the same em-
ployed in fitting new cutting falls sent down
main & royal yard & mast. S. landy this day

Tuesday April 7th 1846

Begins with light breezes from S. by W heading
West sent in flying jib boom middle and latter
part light breezes from the East steering S. West

Wednesday April 8th

Begins with fresh breezes from the East steering
N. W. middle part strong breezes. latter part strong
breezes from S. W. by W. heading. S. W. look in
main top gallant sail. S. landy. Lat. 30° 22' North
Long by chron 166° 13' E

Thursday April 9th

Begins with light air from the S. W. middle
part calm. latter part light winds from the
S. W. hands employed in ships duty. Lat. 31° 40' N Long 165° 16' East

Friday April 10th

Begins with light breezes from the South middle
part wind from the S. W. with rain squalls latter
part wind from the S. W. with fog. S. landy
Lat. 33° 37' N Long 163° 45' E
