

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 27th 1846
All these 24 hours thick fog employed boiling. So Ends
No Obs.

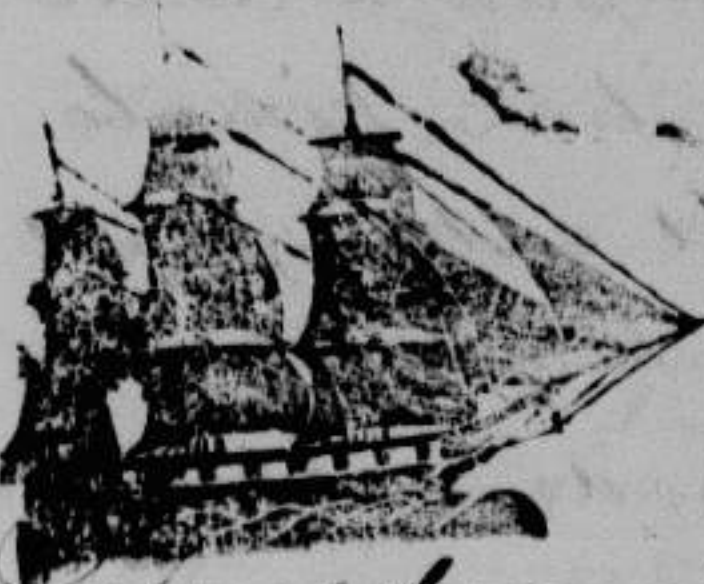
Thursday May 28th 1846
Begins with a calm and calm thick fog employed
boiling at 7 p.m. finished boiling. middle and latter
parts thick fog employed stowing down. So Ends
No Observation

Friday May 29th
commences with light airs from the Western Board
with thick fog at 3 p.m. fog cleared up made sail
nothing in sight middle part pleasant saw one
whale lowered boats could not get fast. So Ends
Lat 41° 57' N. Long 148° 17' E

Saturday May 30th
Begins with light winds from the East at 2 p.m.
fog shut in middle part foggy. latter part cloudy
saw two whales lowered boats could not strike
So Ends
Lat 42° 53' N. Long 148° 58' E

Sunday May 31st
Begins with light winds from the Eastern Board
middle and latter parts the same at 5 a.m.
saw 2 whales lowered boats and missed them
at 6 a.m. saw Staten Island bearing S by N
distance 30 miles. So Ends this day
Latitude 44° 08' North
Longitude 147° 45' East

Remarks on Board Monday June 1st 1846
Begins with fresh breezes from E. & E. by S. at 6 P.M.
spoke ship Francis Penicella of New
Bedford with 128 bbls of sperm oil and 2
right whales middle and latter parts
thick weather. So Ends. No Obs.



Tuesday June 2nd
Begins with fresh winds from the S. & E. and cloudy
one sail in sight middle part the same, latter
part pleasant saw 2 whales lowered
boats struck one killed and took him -
alongside 4 sail in sight and Spangberg island
W. & W distance 25 miles. employed getting ready for
cutting. So Ends. Lat 45° 35' N. Long 146° 30' E.

Wednesday June 3rd
Begins with moderate breezes from the E. & S. & E.
commenced cutting at 10 p.m. finished cutting
and began boiling middle and latter parts -
pleasant employed boiling. 3 sail in sight -
So Ends
Lat 45° 32' N. Long 146° 58' E

Thursday June 4th
Begins with light winds from the S. & E. heading
in for the land at 4 p.m. lashed ship and
bearing S. & S. distance one mile middle and
latter parts pleasant. So Ends.
