

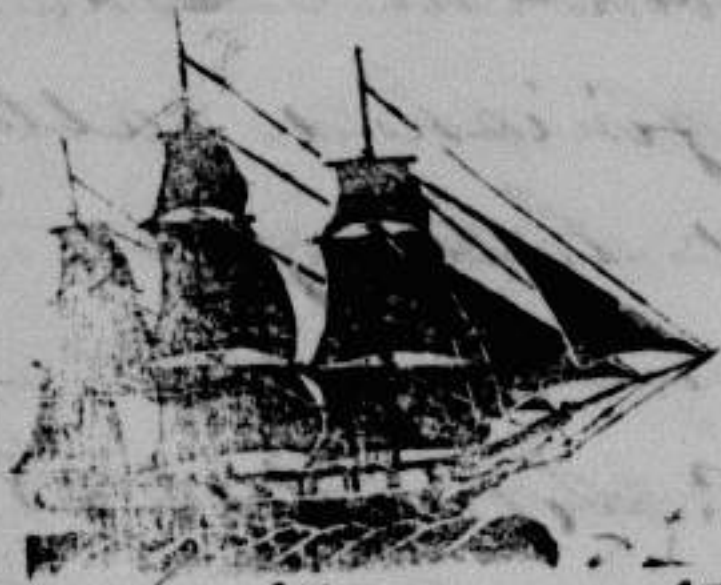
Remarks on Board Friday June 5th 1846
 Begins with light breezes from the S.E. employed
 boiling and stowing down saw a dead
 whale lowered boats and took him to
 the ship at day light - commenced cutting and
 found it to be a drayton took his head throat
 and lips and let his body go. S. Ends with thick
 fog. No observation

Saturday June 6th

Begins with light airs from the Eastern Board
 with fog employed boiling and stowing down middle
 and latter parts the same. finished boiling. S. Ends

Sunday June 7th

Begins with light airs from the S.E. and pleasant
 at 3 p.m. saw one whale lowered



struck him and took him alongside &
 killed him and took him alongside &
 cut him in at 5 p.m. spoke ship
 Washington of New Bedford with
 whaling this season. middle and
 latter parts pleasant. S. Ends. this day

Monday June 8th

All three 24 hours light breezes from the S.E.
 commenced boiling. S. Ends with nothing in sight
 Lat by Obs. 45° 46' N. Long by Chron. 147° 43' W

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 9th 1846 --
 Begins with light breezes from the Southern Board steering
 S.E. with land in sight middle and latter parts the
 same finished boiling. Lat by Obs. 45° 00' N. Long
 by Chron. 148° 11' East.

Wednesday June 10th

Commenced with fresh winds from the Southern
 steering S.E. with fog at 6 p.m. saw the land
 middle and latter parts strong winds steering E.
 Lat. 45° 20' N. Long 150° 19' East

Thursday June 11th

Begins with strong breezes from the Southern
 Board heading East. land in sight. middle part
 the same. latter part foggy. Lat. 45° 41' N.
 Long 152° 26' East

Friday June 12th

Begins with light airs from the South accompanied
 with fog squally steering E by S. middle and lat
 ter part foggy. and calm. Lat. 46° 01' N. Long
 154° 55' East

Saturday June 13th

All three 24 hours light airs from the Western
 Board heading E by S. with fog. Lat. 46° 21' N.
 Long 153° 10' E

Sunday June 14th

Begins with light airs from the West steering
 E by S. middle and latter parts the same.
 Lat. 46° 41' N. Long 155° 24' E
