

Remarks on Board Tuesday Aug 11th 1846
All these 24 hours fresh winds from the West with
thick fog employed sitting up sharks. To Ends. Sails

Wednesday Aug 12th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.W. with fog
and rain. saw whales middle and latter part
the same. To Ends. No Observation

Thursday Aug 13th

Begins with light airs from the S.W. at 1 P.M. fog
cleared off. made sail at sunset saw the island
of Paramousser bearing W.S.W. middle part pleasant
latter part foggy again. To Ends. Lat by Acc. 48° 43' N
Long by Acc. 158° 51' E

Friday Aug 14th

Begins with light breezes from E.S.E. with frequent fog-
squalls. middle and latter parts strong gales and fog
Lat 48° 31' N. Long 158° 21' E

Saturday Aug 15th

Begins with strong gales from E.S.E. under double
reefed maintop sail and foresail. middle part the
same. latter part moderate. saw two right whales how-
ever boats could not get fast. Lat 48° 44' N. Long 158° 15' E

Sunday Aug 16th

The first and middle part fresh
breezes from the S.W. latter part fresh gales laying
to. Latitude 49° 15' N. Long 157° 11' East

Remarks on Board Monday Aug 17th 1846
All these 24 hours strong gales from the Western Wind
laying to. under close reefed maintop sail and foresail. saw
one right whale. To Ends. Lat 49° 28' N. Long 157° 15' E

Tuesday Aug 18th

All these 24 hours strong gales from the Western
Wind laying to doing nothing. To Ends. Lat 49° 21' N
Longitude 157° 01' East

Wednesday Aug 19th

Commenced with fresh winds from the S.W. saw one whale
lowered boats and chased. middle and latter part light
breezes and pleasant nothing in sight. employed clearing
bores. To Ends. Latitude 49° 13' N Longitude 156° 52' E

Thursday Aug 20th

Begins with light breezes from the S.W. steering South
employed clearing bores middle part the same. latter part
heading S.W. one sail in sight. Lat by Acc 48° 58' N
Longitude by Account 148° 31' E

Friday Aug 21st

Begins with light breezes from S.W. at 1 P.M.
saw one whale lowered boats struck
him killed and took him to
the ship and took in sail middle part calm
latter part pleasant employed cutting at 12 minutes
finished. land in sight bearing S.W. distance 50 miles
No Observation
