

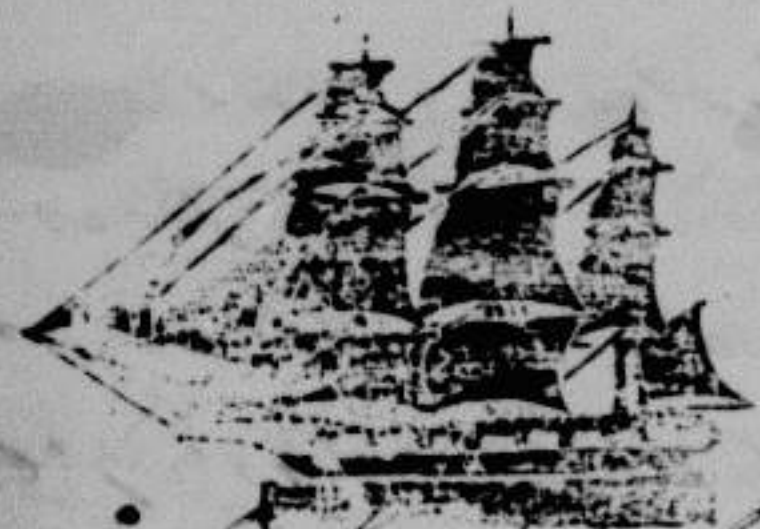
Remarks on Board Saturday Aug 22nd 1846
 Begins with light breezes from the S.E. and pleasant
 at 2 P.M. saw a whale lowered
 boats struck him killed and took
 him alongside and took in sail middle and latter
 parts strong gales. with fog and rain saw one sail. So ends

Sunday Aug 23rd

Begins with strong gales from the S.E. with fog and rain
 employed boiling with one whale alongside middle part
 the same latter part moderate employed cutting one pair
 in sight. Lat by obs. 41° 00' N. Long 159° 27' East

Monday Aug 24th

Begins with fresh breezes from the North. two sail in
 sight. at 5 P.M. finished cutting
 middle part pleasant employed
 boiling. latter part spoke ship
 George of Ware. with 200
 bbls. and ship Henry Lee
 of Sag Harbor with 2500 bbls. This day started for
 HOME. So ends. Latitude, 30° 46' N. Longitude 159° 17'



Tuesday Aug 25th

Begins with light airs from the North and pleasant
 employed boiling and stowing oil. 7 sail in sight. middle
 and latter part cooping oil. So ends this day
 Latitude by observation. 36° 27' N. Longitude 159° 32' E

Remarks on Board Wednesday Aug 26th 1846.
 Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. steering S.E. & employed
 boiling. Middle part the same latter part fresh breezes from
 the West. steering S.E. by E. employed stowing oil and boiling.

Thursday Aug 27th

Begins with fresh breezes from the West with cloudy weather
 steering S.E. by E. employed boiling and stowing oil. middle
 part finished boiling latter part spoke Barque
 Mount Wallston of Fair Haven with 6 whales
 this season have tryworks over board. So ends
 Lat by obs. 48° 49' N. Long. 163° 37' E

Friday Aug 28th

Begins with fresh breezes from W.S.W. steering S.E. by E. with
 thick weather. middle part the same. latter part employed
 stowing down. Latitude. 47° 32' N. Longitude 163° 30' E

Saturday Aug 29th

Begins with light winds from the North and pleasant
 steering S.E. by E. finished stowing oil and set fore topmast
 pludding sail. middle part the same. latter part fresh
 breezes and equally So ends Lat. 46° 30' N. Long 167° 12'

Sunday Aug 30th

Of the first and middle part of these 24 hours fresh
 breezes and equally steering S.E. by E. latter part pleasant
 Latitude by obs. 43° 26' N
 Longitude by Chron 168° 47' East
