

Remarks on Board Thursday Sept 10th 1846
Begins with light breezes from S.E. heading East with
all sail set employed tacking one middle and latter
parts light air from E.S.E. heading S.E. So ends

Latitude 40° 27' N Long 173° 21' E

Friday Sept 11th

Begins with light air from the S.E. heading S.E. by E
employed tacking one middle and latter parts the
same finished tacking 213 bunches of line. So ends

Lat 41° 03' N. Long 172° 04' West

Saturday Sept 12th

All these 24 hours light and bafflin winds from
the Southern Board heading E. S.E. employed in ship
duty. Latitude 40° 56' N. Longitude 171° 17' West

Sunday Sept 13th

Begins with light winds from the South heading E. S.E.
middle part strong breezes. latter part equally employed
cleaning the ship. Lat 39° 56' N. Long 170° 02' West

Monday Sept 14th Begins with light winds from the
S.W. steering S.E. by E middle and latter parts from
rain equally employed cleaning ship Lat 38° 33' N
Long 167° 56' E

Tuesday Sept 15th Begins with light air from S
by W steering S.E. by E middle part the same latter part
wind from the S.W. steering S.E. Latitude 37° 39' North
Longitude 166° 00' West

Remarks on Board Wednesday Sept 16th 1846
Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. and equally steering
S.E. with all sail set middle part light airs. latter part
calm, employed in ship's duty. Latitude 36° 41' North

Longitude 165° 15' West

Thursday Sept 17th 1846

Commences with light air from the S.W. middle part
light breezes from the S.W. latter part wind from
the S.W. steering S.E. by E. So ends Lat 35° 47' North

Longitude 164° 02' West

Friday Sept 18th

All these 24 hours light breezes from the S.W. steering
S.E. by E. with all sail set employed in ship's duty.

Lat 34° 45' N. Long 163° 21' E

Saturday Sept 19th

All these 24 hours light winds from the S.W. steering
S.E. by E. with all sail set. Latitude 33° 20' N. Long

Longitude 161° 03' West

Sunday Sept 20th

All these 24 hours light and pleasant breezes from
the S.W. steering S.E. by E. Latitude 32° 38' North

Longitude 160° 11' West

Monday Sept 21st

All these 24 hours light winds from the S.W.
steering S.E. by E. employed mending the main
sail. So ends. Latitude 31° 32' N. Long

Longitude 158° 35' West
