

Remarks on Board Tuesday Sept 22^d 1846

All three 24 hours light breezes from the Southern
Board heading E.S.E. bent the mainsail. So Ends

Lat by Obs 30° 55' N. Long by Chron 155° 52' W

Wednesday Sept 23^d

All three 24 hours light breezes from the Southern
Board heading E.S.E. with all sail set employed in
ships duty. So Ends. Latitude 30° 27' N. Long 156° 52' W

Thursday Sept 24^d

Begins with light winds from the South heading
E.S.E. sent up fore and mizzen royal mast one sail
in sight. So Ends. 27° 53' N. Longitude 156° 53' W

Friday Sept 25^d

Begins with light air and bafflin
middle part light winds from the S
spoke ship Cores of Sea Bedford with
100 bbls of oil. So Ends. Lat 28° 48' N.
Long 155° 35' W

Saturday Sept 26^d

All three 24 hours pleasant breezes from the S.E.
staring S.E. by E. & two sail in sight heading South
Lat 27° 09' N. Long 155° 29' W

Sunday Sept 27^d All three 24 hours light air
and pleasant. saw two ships steering Southward.

Latitude by Obs 24° 55' N.
Longitude by Chron 155° 35' W

Remarks on Board Monday Sept 28^d 1846

All three 24 hours fresh winds from E.S.E. steering S
by E with all sail set handy employed in ships duty.

Lat by Obs 33° 25' N. Long 155° 35' W

Tuesday Sept 29^d

Commenced with fresh breezes from the Eastern Board
steering S by E with all sail set middle part the same
latter part saw the island of Nance bearing S by W
distance 50 miles. Lat 31° 29' N. Long 156° 00' West

Wednesday Sept 30^d

Begins with light breezes from E.S.E. standing in for
the land at 11 took ship at daylight - kept off sailing
down the land. So Ends. No Observation

Thursday Oct 1st 1846

Begins with light breezes from the S.E. running down
the island of Nance at 10 P.M. came to an anchor middle
and latter parts calm. one water in liberty. So Ends

Friday Oct 2^d

All three 24 hours light winds and pleasant took
on board 100 bbls of water. one water in liberty.

Saturday Oct 3^d

All three 24 hours light winds and pleasant employed
painting ship several ships came in and anchored.
water in liberty. So Ends.
