Lat 33° 12' South. Long 154° 00' West

Thursday Nov 19th

All these 24 hours lighter winds from the Western Board steering S.E. with all sail set hands employed in ship's duty. Latitude 34° 20' South
Longitude 151° 59' West

Friday Nov 20th

Begins with fresh winds from the Western Board steering S.E. middle part moderate latter part calm.
Latitude 35° 30' S. Long 150° 32' West

Saturday Nov 21st

These 24 hours first part calm middle part the same latter part light breezes from the S.W. employed mending sails. Latitude 35° 56' South
Longitude 149° 36' West

Sunday Nov 22nd

The fore and middle part calm light winds from the S.W. steering S.E. with all sail set latter part calm. Lat 36° 40' S. Long 148° 58' West

Monday Nov 23rd

These 24 hours first and middle part light breezes and baffles latter part fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.E. Lat 37° 16' S. Long 147° 03' West

Tuesday Nov 24th

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E. with cloudy weather steering S.E. at 5 P.M. fresh gales took in studding sails flying jib and main royal. middle and latter part strong gales under double reefed topsails S.W.
Lat 37° 22' South. Long 146° 06' West

Wednesday Nov 25th

Begins with strong gales from the Western Board steering E.S.E. under fore and main topsails and foresail. middle part hard squalls took in fore and main topsails and double reefed the main latter part heavy gales sending under close reefed main topsail and foresail S. ends
Lat 40° 20' S. Long 145° 01' West

Thursday Nov 26th

Begins with strong gales from the Western Board steering East. under close reefed topsail and foresail at 6 P.M. more moderate set fore and main topsails middle part the same latter part fresh breezes. S. ends
Lat 39° 36' S. Long 139° 50' West

Friday Nov 27th

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from the Western Board steering E by S. with all sail set
Lat 40° 39' S. Long 136° 50' West

Saturday Nov 28th Begins with strong winds from the S.W. steering E by S. middle part the same latter part more moderate set top gallant studding sail. Latitude 42° 38' S. Long 133° 50' West
