

Ship Indian Chief bound for New London  
Sunday Jan<sup>y</sup> 10<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light breezes from the Western Board heading  
N by E. middle part light air from the Southern Board, latter  
part fresh winds from E. & S. Latitude by Obs. 25° 51' South  
Longitude by Chron. 25° 51' West

Monday Jan<sup>y</sup> 11<sup>th</sup>

All three 24 hours light breezes from the Eastern Board  
steering N by E. employed mending sails. Lat by Obs. 27° 38' S  
Long by Chron. 26° 25' W

Tuesday Jan<sup>y</sup> 12<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light breezes from the Eastern Board steering  
N by E. middle part the same latter part light  
air exchanged signals with an English ship who was still  
South. Latitude by Obs. 26° 46' S. Longitude by Chron. 26° 56' W

Wednesday Jan<sup>y</sup> 13<sup>th</sup>

All three 24 hours light air from the Eastern Board  
heading N by E. with all sail set. Latitude 25° 12' S  
Longitude 27° 10' West

Thursday Jan<sup>y</sup> 14<sup>th</sup>

All three 24 hours light air from E & S heading to  
the Northward. Latitude 24° 39' S. Longitude 27° 29' W

Friday Jan<sup>y</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> Commences with light breezes  
from E by S heading N by E. middle part the same latter  
part heading N by W. Latitude by Obs. 23° 14' S  
Longitude by Chron. 28° 18' West.

Ship Indian Chief bound for New London  
Saturday Jan<sup>y</sup> 16<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light breezes from the S & heading N by W. middle  
and latter part heading N by E. Latitude by Obs. 22° 01' South  
Longitude by Chron. 28° 25' West

Sunday Jan<sup>y</sup> 17<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breezes from the Eastern Board heading  
N by E. middle part the same latter part strong breezes from  
E & S. at 11 AM saw Martin Van Breck bearing N by E dist 25 miles  
Latitude 20° 20' S. Longitude 29° 10' W

Monday Jan<sup>y</sup> 18<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastern Board steering  
N by E. middle and latter part the same. Latitude 18° 10' S  
Longitude 29° 46' W

Tuesday Jan<sup>y</sup> 19<sup>th</sup>

All three 24 hours fresh breezes from the Eastern Board  
steering N by E. with all sail set. Latitude 15° 54' S  
Longitude 30° 18' West

Wednesday Jan<sup>y</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>

All three 24 hours fresh South East trades steering  
N by E. saw 2 sail heading South. 200 studs in sight  
Latitude 13° 58' S. Longitude 30° 46' W

Thursday Jan<sup>y</sup> 21<sup>st</sup>

Begins with fresh trades steering N by East with  
everything set middle and latter part steering  
N by E employed in the rigging. So ends this day  
Latitude by Observation 11° 48' S  
Longitude by Chronometer 31° 20' W
