

Ship Indian Chief Bound for the
Tuesday Feb 16th

Commence with light airs saw two sails. middle
part pleasant breezes from the N.E. latter part fresh wind
and equally. No observation this day.

Wednesday Feb 17th

All these 24 hours light breezes from the N.E. steering
N.W. by E. Latitude 27° 45' N. Long by Acc - 65° 47' West

Thursday Feb 18th

All these 24 hours light airs and calm saw 2
sails and any quantity of Sulphur Weed. Lat. 28° 23' N
Long. 64° 33' West

Friday Feb 19th

Begins with light airs from the Eastern Board on middle
and latter parts light winds from the N.E. 2 sail in
sight. Latitude 28° 48' N. Longitude 65° 35' West

Saturday Feb 20th

Begins with light airs from the N.E. one sail
in sight. middle part light winds from W. S. W.
Heading North. latter part heading N.E. by E. So ends
Lat. 29° 39' N. Long 65° 05' W.

Sunday Feb 21st Begins with light airs and calm
heading N.E. middle and latter parts dead calm with mists
in sight but Sulphur Weed. So ends. Latitude 29° 50' North
Longitude 65° 05' West.

United States of America in 1843: 1848.
Monday Feb 22nd

Begins with light breezes from the N.W. steering N.W. by N.
middle part fresh winds from the N.W. by N. latter part the
same. Latitude by Obs. 31° 10' N. Longitude by Obs. 66° 47' W.

Tuesday Feb 23rd

Commence with strong breezes from the N.W. steering
N.W. by N. with all sail set. middle part strong winds
took in fore and mizzen top gallant sails and flying jib.
and double reefed the topsails. took in jib and main
sail. latter part took in fore and mizzen topsails with
strong gales from the N.W. heading on different tacks
Lat. 32° 25' N. Long. 67° 25' W.

Wednesday Feb 24th

Begins with strong breezes from the N.W. under
close reefed topsails. middle part the same latter
part more moderate but the reefs out of the topsails
and set the maintop gallant sail. Lat. 32° 28' N
Long 67° 32' West.

Thursday Feb 25th

Begins with fresh winds from the Northern
Board. heading N.W. by N. middle part calm and
light airs from the Eastern Board. latter part
fresh breezes saw a schooner and a brig standing
to the Eastward. So ends. Latitude 32° 57' N
Longitude by Obs 68° 32' W.
