

Phasing in the South

Tuesday
February 7th 1837
These 24 hours light trades and
Sea working to windward. All
4 ships in sight with main tacks
down saw nothing Sat by obs 5^h 28^m 0^{sec}

Wednesday
February 8th
Strong trades and passing clouds
at 4 Pell spoke ship Frequent
Ottison 26 months out 2310
and Barclay in company
Pell worked out for a store
Dill broke out the after hole
and began to stow several ships in
sight doing nothing saw ship
jacks and flying fish
we shall see the flying
next stowed down
Sat by obs 5^h 15^m 0^{sec}

Thursday
February 9th
At 4 Pell finished stowing
out at the same time spoke
ship Young Eagle of N. 200 bbls
Cooker Master
gang of Royal reging latter part
rainy as obs

Friday
February 10th
Begins with strong trades and
thick weather at 4 Pell tacked
in 2 ships in sight got the
Royal reging aloft latter part
light winds and clear
Sat by obs 5^h 26^m
Long 102^h 20^m

Phasing in the South

Saturday
February 11th 1837
Paying with light trades and clear
standing at 6 Pell hauled
T. G. Seils & flying jib and hauled
up the courses at day light in
the morning were ship to the
set all drawing sail and steered
Southward in sight

Sat by obs 5^h 26^m

Sunday
February 12th 1837
Frosty part light winds morning
off at 11 latter part strong
breezes and passing clouds saw
A pinback and 3 ships standing
Sat by obs 6^h 47^m

Long by Luner 100^h 35^m
Long by Chron 100^h 40^m

Monday
February 13th 1837
Strong trades and flying clouds
at 1 Pell were and ran north Pell
saw 2 pinbacks at 6 Pell hauled
T. G. Seils and j. jib & hauled up
the m. course at day light in the
morning made sail and steered
Sat by obs 5^h 05^m

Long by Chron 102^h 40^m

Tuesday
February 14th
Strong trades and rough at 4 Pell
took Luner Observation by measuring
the Dist. of the moon from the sun
At meridian saw a sail to windward
flying to windward and tacking as
requisite Sat by obs 5^h 07^m

Long by Luner Reduced to baron 102^h 20^m
