out 200 lbs got a letter and some
papers at 6 Pell stored south at
11 words

February 21st moderate at 7 still wore ships
and stored in nothing in
sight - employed weaving mats
grafting making them fine
Sail for 5:34
Song 10:00

Saturday Strong trades and heavy standing
February 18th S.E. at 4 Pell 4 ships in sight
all standing South at 7 still
were to the South 2 ships in
sight standing Court
Sail by 5:45

February 21st with rain Latter part clear at
9 still spoke ship George of 115
Hammered master 6 months out
200 lbs
