Monday
October 16th
A strong S & E trades and cloudy course from S by E to S by E.
No obs.

Tuesday
Oct 17th
Wind and weather much the same as yesterday. saw finbacks. Course S by E by S.
Lat by 23.07
Long by 74.20 W

Wednesday
October 18th
These 24 hours strong trades and cloudy courses from S by E to S by E. wind from East to S by E. all hands busy scrimshawing & that is what I call a double Dutch word coined against the Sun. the air is uncommonly cold which makes it quite tedious steering on the heels.
Lat by 21.23 A
Long by 74.25 W

From A cruise bound to Oahu

Thursday
October 19th
Strong trades from the S & E and cloudy most of the time. Courses from S by E to North sea. Blackfish towed a boat did not fasten some.
Lat 19.23 South

Friday
October 20th
Strong trades and passing clouds. Course North and S by E. employed steering ship out side and in. saw finbacks water discovered.
Lat by 16.55 S
Long 77.40 W

Saturday
October 21st
Light S & E trades and clear weather. Courses from North to S by E. saw a great number of finbacks. water uncommonly thick and of a reddish blue tinted. The water cools and I hear the out side. sent up the fly sail poles.
Lat by 15.00 South
Long 77.31 West

Sunday
October 22nd
Moderate trades and clear weather at 6 AM made the land. Dist 35 miles by Est. Crews S and S by E.
Lat 13.24 North
